I, {full legal name} BRANT C. LICKISS, in my position as {job title} Deputy Sheriff II with the {name of law enforcement officer/agency} Volusia County Sheriff Office, swear and affirm that the following facts are true and correct.

1. {Name of Respondent} [REDACTED] poses a significant danger of causing personal injury to himself/herself or others by having a firearm or any ammunition in his/her custody or control or by purchasing, possessing or receiving a firearm or any ammunition. The following specific statements, actions, or facts give rise to a reasonable fear of significant dangerous acts by the respondent:

\*\*\*BWC RECORDING\*\*\* On 07/23/2020, at 1014 hours, Deputy Lickiss responded to [REDACTED] in reference to a suicidal person. Prior to Deputy Lickiss' arrival, responding deputies had made contact with [REDACTED] (V1), [REDACTED] (R1) and [REDACTED] (O1) in the parking lot of the above mentioned address

**AFFIDAVIT CONTINUATION**

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After briefly speaking with [REDACTED] deputies made contact with [REDACTED]. Upon making contact with [REDACTED] It was discovered he had a S&W .357 revolver in his right front pocket. Deputies immediately secured the firearm. Deputies again made contact with [REDACTED] who advised the following;

[REDACTED] stated as she, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were leaving the Doctor's office to take [REDACTED] to Deland, she heard him make several comments about "shooting the next person to walk through the door". [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] continued on by stating he wished to walk to his residence, so he could walk into traffic. [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] stated he was "going to take a dirt nap" when he got home. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] continued making the suicidal comments, and ranted on about shooting others and himself for several minutes.

[REDACTED] further advised [REDACTED] behavior has become worse over the past several days. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] has made several comments about shooting other's and himself, and tried to get to his firearm prior to them stopping him. [REDACTED] stated a few days prior, [REDACTED] advised he was going to call his brother, and shoot him as he was coming through the door. [REDACTED] advised she and [REDACTED] took [REDACTED] to the Doctor today, due to his statements and behavior, to suggest a possible change in medication. [REDACTED] stated the Doctor wrote them an immediate referral to Deland Hospital for [REDACTED] to be evaluated for confucion and depression. [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] owns several firearms within his residence. [REDACTED] completed a written statement.

Deputies made contact with [REDACTED] who corroborated [REDACTED] statements. [REDACTED] went on to advise that when deputies arrived on scene, [REDACTED] became extremely agitated. [REDACTED] stated while Deputies were briefly speaking with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] advised her he was going to shoot the deputy. [REDACTED] advised she then threw her hands up, to get deputies attention. [REDACTED] advised she does not believe [REDACTED] is in the right state of mind, due to making several suicidal statements throughout the past few days. [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] has threatened to "Blow his brains out" on numerous occasions. [REDACTED] completed a written statement.

Deputies made contact with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] denied ever making any suicidal statements, and advised deputies he would never shoot a law enforcement officer, and instead would use his firearm to protect one that was in danger. [REDACTED] continued to deny ever making suicidal statements.

Deputy Lickiss determined without an immediate mental health evaluation, there is a substantial likelihood [REDACTED] will cause harm to himself or others. [REDACTED] was taken into protective custody under a Baker act.
