BWC ACTIVATED** [REDACTED] advised he wished to have his information remain confidential in reference to Marsy's Law***On 09/03/2020 at approximately 1645 hours, Deputy Skrzypinski was dispatched to the area of N US HWY 17 and Bunnell Rd, Seville, in reference to a disturbance. Prior to arrival, Central Dispatch advised the incident was in relation to road rage incident where one half brandished a firearm then fled the scene. Upon arrival, Deputy Skrzypinski made contact with [REDACTED] (VI) who advised the following:

[REDACTED] stated he was traveling northbound on Hwy 17 coming into Seville operating a [REDACTED] Kia car bearing FL tag [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised he was behind a [REDACTED] Lincoln car bearing FL tag [REDACTED] which was driving slowly. [REDACTED] advised he was approximately one car length behind the vehicle when he moved towards the southbound lane to see if it was safe to pass. [REDACTED] advised as he sped up to pass the Lincoln, the driver, later identified as [REDACTED] (SI), stopped abruptly almost causing [REDACTED] to impact the rear of the Lincoln with his Kia. [REDACTED] again tried to pass the Lincoln and as he was passing the driver of the Lincoln sped up in an attempt to keep [REDACTED] from passing him. [REDACTED] advised he was able to overtake the Lincoln at which time [REDACTED] intentionally impacted the rear [REDACTED] Kia leaving a small scratch on the rear passenger side of the bumper. [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] then sped past him and brandished a small black pistol in the window. [REDACTED] advised he then backed off and dialed [REDACTED] for assistance. [REDACTED] advised he did follow the vehicle for a short while so he could give an accurate description of the vehicle to law enforcement. [REDACTED] advised the firearm was not pointed in his direction, only displayed in a reckless manner. [REDACTED] completed a sworn written statement indicating he wished to pursue charges.

Deputy Skrzypinski made contact with [REDACTED] (W1) ([REDACTED] passenger) who corroborated [REDACTED] account of the incident. [REDACTED] advised as they tried to pass the Lincoln [REDACTED] became enraged and tried to run their vehicle off the road at one point striking them from behind. [REDACTED] advised when [REDACTED] passed them, she saw a small black pistol in his hand which he was holding up so [REDACTED] and herself could see, being display in a reckless manner. [REDACTED] completed a sworn written statement.

Deputy Skrzypinski responded to [REDACTED], Seville, and made contact with [REDACTED] Deputy Skrzypinski advised [REDACTED] of his Constitutional Rights under Miranda from his agency issued card. [REDACTED] advised he understood his rights and wished to speak to Deputy Skrzypinski. Post Miranda [REDACTED] advised he was traveling northbound on US Hwy 17 when a white car pulled up behind him and began tailgating him. [REDACTED] advised he slowed down to allow the vehicle to pass. [REDACTED] stated when the vehicle passed the driver cut him off and stopped abruptly causing [REDACTED] to impact the rear of the Kia with the driver's side front of his Lincoln. [REDACTED] advised he then pulled his concealed firearm for which he has a concealed carry license and waved it up in the air inside of his vehicle. [REDACTED] advised he did this because he was angry. [REDACTED] advised he then continued to his residence.
