On 09/30/2020 at approximately 1813 hours, Volusia Sheriff's Office Central Dispatch received a phone
call from (R1) concerning a message she had received from (D1)
which caused her to believe may be suicidal. A request was made to Seminole County Sheriff's
Office to meet with at her residence. Deputy Adamczyk and additional deputies went to
residence, Debary, in order to assess mental health status. stated
had sent a message "stating this is not the easy way" and a video of pulling the trigger
of an unloaded handgun pointed at his head. Also stated was ex-military and there were a
lot of firearms at the residence. Included lived at the residence with his mother and father.
Upon arriving at residence, deputies were able to contact mother,
(O1), and his father, (O2). The parents confirmed there were firearms inside the
residence but they believed them to all be secured inside a safe, except for a shotgun near the pool area.
daughter stated her father had purchased some other firearms but to her knowledge they were at
house. Several attempts were made to contact by phone without success. Deputies then
requested to call for her son from the garage area, where deputies were standing. After
several minutes, came into the garage, began a conversation with a deputy and then attempted to
retreat into the residence. Deputy Terrero followed and was able to physically contain
until other deputies arrived to assist placing into handcuffs until the suicidal statement could be
investigated.
refused to comply with requests made by deputies to place his arms behind his back to be
secured. demanded to know why deputies were in the house and stated he would not comply
until he knew why deputies were present. Deputy Adamczyk then told of the Well Being Check
