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explained that he and his wife, (V1), have been in a relationship for five years
and have lived together for four years. They have no children in common.
drinking alcohol with some friends at their residence. advised their friends left for the night and

then advised both of them separated and she went to the bedroom and got into bed. She explained she
got on the phone and called . She then observed go into the closet and
place his firearm in their safe before going outside to wait for Deputies to arrive.
there were no witnesses to the incident. completed a sworn written statement detailing the incident and advised she did not call and did not want to pursue charges provided deputies

vith access to sirearm a Walther PPS 9mm handgun (serial # AY9427), along with two
magazines, and six 9mm rounds from the safe located in the bedroom closet.
relinquish her firearm which she stated was hidden elsewhere in the residence. She described her firearm
as a Glock 9mm handgun. Based on the statements made and the evidence observed Deputies were able to
establish probable cause to arrest for domestic violence battery for intentionally striking
against her will and aggravated assault for intentionally and unlawfully threatening via the act
of pointing the firearm at her head and placing her in fear that such violence was imminent.
