The argument ended and continued down the street to walk his dog, at which got into his vehicle to go to the gas station. time stated when he got to the intersection of Glenridge Ter and Cottondale Dr, Fillon stood in the middle of the street and began yelling profanities at him and spitting in the direction of his vehicle. On the way back from the gas station, Pena Torres advised he encountered Fillon again at the same intersection, and another verbal altercation began, stated at this time, Fillon pulled out a firearm from behind his back and held it at his side while stating "I am going to kill you". Pena described the firearm as a small black handgun which would be located in the area of back pocket. At this point, called for law enforcement to respond in reference to the incident. completed a sworn written statement and advised he wished to pursue criminal charges. Deputies provided with a victim's rights pamphlet which contained a case number. Contact was made with at the intersection of Glenridge Ter and Cottondale Dr, at which time he was secured in handcuffs. Deputies located a black, Ruger LC9 handgun tucked in pants on the

small of his back. Post Miranda, stated a verbal altercation did occur, however he never brandished his firearm during the incident. said the altercation occurred at the intersection because he believed said the altercation occurred at the intersection because he believed attempted to run him over while driving down the road. other firearms and there were none inside the residence. had no further information to provide in reference to the incident.

While on scene, deputies observed no injuries to any parties involved. Photographs were taken of and later uploaded to the digital crime scene database. The firearm, holster, and ammunition were entered into the District 4 Evidence Locker.

Based on witness statements and physical evidence, Deputy Akeley determined probable cause existed to with aggravated assault deadly weapon. intentionally and unlawfully threatened by charge coupled with the apparent ability to do so, and doing some act word or act to do violence to created a well-founded fear in such person that violence was imminent.
