Deputy Cowger and Deputy Armstrong arrived on scene and approached on foot towards the house. Once at the house Deputy Cowger and Deputy Armstrong positioned themselves at the corner of the home where they had a visual of the front door. Deputy Cowger was advised by Central Dispatch there were no updates and it was assumed the male, later identified as [REDACTED] was still armed. Central Dispatch then advised the female, later identified as [REDACTED] (V1), law enforcement was outside her home and instructed her to exit. [REDACTED] along with her son, [REDACTED] (O1), began to exit the home, at which [REDACTED] began chasing after them. [REDACTED] then exited the home and was given lawful commands by Deputy Armstrong and Deputy Cowger to "get on the ground" which he refused to do. Based upon the information given involving a firearm (which unknown if still in [REDACTED]'s possession) and the immediately safety of [REDACTED] along with [REDACTED], Deputy Cowger deployed his department X26 Taser (serial #X29007KN5). The first deployment stuck [REDACTED] in his left arm with one probe and subsequently the additional probe made no contact with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] still was not going to the ground and Deputy Cowger redeployed the second cartridge from his Taser which stuck [REDACTED] in the center mass of his chest and stomach, causing him to go to the ground. It should be noted in CAD at 2356 hours, while [REDACTED] is still in contact with Central Dispatch Operators, they noted she stated "he's coming after me now" as she was exiting her home and moments prior to Deputy Cowger's Taser deployment. Deputy Armstrong secured [REDACTED] in handcuffs.

Volusia County Fire Rescue respond to the scene and removed the Taser probes from [REDACTED] item# 3. Sergeant Ruiz arrived on scene and was made aware of what transpired prior to his arrival.

Deputy Cowger spoke with [REDACTED] who advised the following: she was in a political discussion with [REDACTED] over the events which took place in Washington D.C. Prior in the night, [REDACTED] then contacted an out of state friend via telephone while [REDACTED] was lying in bed. [REDACTED] and her began to once again argue because he did not like the response he was given. This secondary argument caused [REDACTED] (O1) to be woken up, which [REDACTED] then attended to and put back to bed. This caused [REDACTED] to become more upset at which time the two got into another argument and [REDACTED] grabbed [REDACTED] by both of her arms, squeezed them, and then released her. [REDACTED] then began picking up the bed and bed post and slamming it on the ground. [REDACTED] advised him to never touch her or put his hands on her again. [REDACTED] then heard the "racking" of a firearm and observed [REDACTED] put a handgun to his chin. [REDACTED] called 911 and waited for law enforcement to arrive. [REDACTED] advised she was instructed to exited the home and once she did she was followed by [REDACTED] who told her "you're not taking my son". Deputy Cowger observed minor bruising on [REDACTED]'s right arm, who also refused any medical attention.

Deputy Cowger spoke with [REDACTED] who stated the events prior to his arrival were: "she stated I was out of control, that's it". [REDACTED] provided no further information.

[REDACTED] completed a statement, and was provided a Victims Right's and Remedies paper work which was explained to her, along with Marsy' Law Form, which she requested NOT TO MAKE HER INFORMATION PUBLIC.
