Salinas was speaking with Deputy Bissonnette advised there was probable cause for
an arrest. Deputy Salinas placed under arrest and was read his constitutional rights
which he waived and agreed to speak with deputies without a lawyer present.
put his hand up in close proximity to his face and he then swatted
hand away. was asked if he reached or brandished a pistol to which he stated no.
advised he does not own a pistol, but does own a rifle. A search of person
met with negative results for a firearm.
Deputies also spoke with (O1), (O1), significantly girlfriend, and advised the following:
She heard yelling coming from outside of her home and went outside to investigate. She saw
and the neighbor arguing and then witnessed slap with an open hand.
She then saw reach for a gun on his right hip. also saw 3 men approach to offer
aid. stayed in the carport area because she was not sure what would happen.
completed a sworn written statement.
Deputy Bissonnette reviewed video surveillance footage and observed slap
at the 08:40:26 time mark. At the 08:40:29 time mark reach towards his right
hip which would be consistent with reaching for for a pistol.

While in Deputy Salinas' custody complained about feeling dizzy and explained he suffers with high blood pressure and inconsistent heart rhythm. Deputy Salinas transported to Volusia County Fire Service Station 11 where he was evaluated. was observed to have an irregular heart rhythm, high blood pressure, and low pulse. He was then transported by EVAC to Halifax Hospital, Daytona Beach where he was admitted for further observation.
A criminal history was ran on which met with negative results.
Based on the facts and statements provided during the investigation, Deputy Salinas has probable cause to believe committed battery on a person 65 years of age or older as well as aggravated assault on
