her bedroom, and obtained a loaded handgun from an unlocked safe. If followed her into the bedroom,

and attempted to remove a "tactical bag" from it; however, stopped her before she could grab it. The
bag contained other firearms. Shortly thereafter, left the residence, and immediately
contacted the Volusia Sheriff's Office for assistance.
It should be noted, advised never pointed the firearm at herself.
While on scene, Deputies tactically entered the residence, and secured in handcuffs. Deputy
Bryant interviewed her about the incident which revealed the following:
She felt sad and "desperate" because of an argument with her significant other,
stemmed from financial issues. During the argument, entered her bedroom, and obtained a
handgun from the inside of the unlocked safe. did not know how to use the firearm, nor "did she
plan on it." She was unable to provided a reason of why she removed it from inside the safe. Furthermore,
she mentioned she also thought about grabbing the shotgun from inside the tactical bag.
Through investigation and statements made by and it was determined there was a substantial
likelihood that without the proper care or treatment would do serious bodily harm to herself in the
near future. Based upon this, Deputy Johnson placed her into protective custody under the Baker Act, and
she was transported to Stewart Marchman for further evaluation.
