had PTSD which was triggered by stress. _____ advised he was reaching out for help and did
not have any weapons. Upon Deputies arrival, they made contact with _____ outside of his
residence. _____ appeared intoxicated but was cooperative with Deputies. _____ advised
the following information:

He was lonely and stressed by work related issues. During the conversation _____ repeatedly
mentioned that he was thinking of putting a bullet in his head. _____ stated he called 911 for
help instead of shooting himself in his head, and that Deputy Gourley saved his life by coming to
speak with him.

Based on the totality of the circumstance, Deputy Langdon determined there is a substantial
likelihood that without care or treatment, _____ would likely cause serious bodily harm or
death to himself in the near future, as evidenced by his recent behavior and statements.
Therefore, _____ was placed into protective custody under the Baker Act guidelines.
