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****MARSY'S LAW INVOKED****

On 12/01/2023 at approximately 0300 hours, Deputy Campbell responded to _____ Deland (Dixie's Gentlemens Club), in reference to a trespassing complaint. Prior to arrival, the reporting party informed VSO Central Dispatch an unruly patron was refusing to leave the property and was armed with a firearm.

Upon arrival, contact was made with staff at the rear of the building, who were standing with _____ the manager of the bar, informed deputies that _____ refused to leave the property and was armed with a firearm, which he drew on staff. _____ was secured after refusing to cooperate with deputies, leave the property, and a Glock 43x was recovered from under his waistline. While continuing the investigation, _____ stated he would not speak with law enforcement without a lawyer present.

_____ stated prior to law enforcement's arrival, he was with a security guard, _____ and they asked _____ to leave the property due to the business closing. _____ informed Deputy Campbell _____ refused and walked to the woodline where his vehicle was parked. _____ stated when _____ returned, he became confrontational and drew a black handgun from his waistline and stated "I have a strap," while taking an aggressive stance and holding the firearm pointed towards the ground. _____ stated he was in a well-founded fear _____ would use the firearm against him to cause harm. _____ completed a sworn written statement wishing to pursue charges. _____ also completed a Marsy's Law Form, wishing to keep his information confidential.

Deputies then contacted _____ who works as a security guard for the business. _____ stated _____ was a belligerent customer who later became aggressive and was asked to leave by staff. _____ was then seen going to where his vehicle was parked in the parking lot. _____ stated _____ returned from his vehicle, drew a firearm from his waistband and stated he was armed with a "strap." _____ stated when _____ drew his firearm, he was in fear _____ would use it against him. _____ completed a sworn written statement, wishing to pursue charges against _____. _____ completed a Marsy's Law Form wishing to keep his information confidential.

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Based on statements made and evidence observed at the scene, it was determined _____ refused to leave the establishment after being asked several times and in the presence of law enforcement while armed with a firearm. _____ also drew the firearm in a threatening manner towards _____ and _____ and they had a well-founded fear violence would be caused to them. Ultimately _____ was placed under arrest and charged with trespassing on property while armed and aggravated assault with a firearm.

An inventory search of _____'s vehicle yielded a small amount of a white powdery substance, believed to be cocaine. _____'s firearm, a Glock Model 43x (serial# BPBC300) was recovered and placed into evidence. An FCIC/NCIC search yielded the firearm was not stolen. A criminal history search for _____ yielded no felony convictions. A Risk Protection Order was petitioned for _____
