

It should be note, the family was in an argument via text messages over ██████████ providing a lollipop candy containing CBD to his mother, ██████████ (O1). ██████████ also consumed a CBD lollipop. ██████████ was not on scene due to being at work, but arrived on scene at a later time. While waiting for ██████████ to arrive on scene, contact was finally made with ██████████ granted deputies permission to enter the residence to locate ██████████. It was determined ██████████ was not home and the ██████████ SUV he utilizes was not in the garage.

██████████ and ██████████ had all their firearms accounted for which were stored in a safe. They were unaware of ██████████ owning a firearm. During the search for ██████████ in his room, no firearm was located in plain view. ██████████ completed a sworn written statement.

A ping was initiated on ██████████'s phone and a BOLO was disseminated for ██████████. The most recent location for ██████████ was at 0337 hours in the area of ██████████ Ormond Beach. Deputies bolo'd the area and Deputy Greene located ██████████ operating the ██████████ at the intersection of Seabreeze Drive and Sea Harbor. Deputy Greene secured ██████████ in handcuffs without incident. ██████████ explained the handgun was in fact a BB gun.

██████████ was given a courtesy ride to the location of the ██████████ so she could safely secure the vehicle at their residence.

Deputy Salinas determined there is a substantial likelihood that without care or treatment ██████████ will cause serious bodily harm to himself. Deputy Greene placed ██████████ into protective custody under Baker Act. Deputy Greene transported ██████████ to Halifax Hospital without incident.

Deputy Salinas took photographs of ██████████'s Apple watch of the messages he received. Due to ██████████ having ██████████ phone number blocked the messages were never received on his phone. Those photographs were later uploaded to the digital crime scene database.

Deputy Salinas contacted VSO TTY to enter ██████████ in as missing and endangered. Deputy Salinas spoke with Operator 9400 who advised the entry would be made by Operator 8128. ██████████ was located prior to the FCIC/NCIC entry. Deputy Salinas spoke with VSO TTY to make them aware and cancel the entry from being made.

Deputy Salinas will be generating a RPO for ██████████
