| Deputy Williams determined states actions could reasonably be expected to result in physical or mental injury to a child. |
| It should also be noted that Deputy Williams completed a Risk Protection Order with respondent. Deputies asked if she would be willing to voluntarily surrender the firearms in the residence, however, she declined to do so as she wished to keep them for her protection. |
| Deputy Williams also faxed a copy of this report to DCF for further review. |
| Based on statement, 's statements, and the evidence observed, Deputy Williams determined to be the primary aggressor. Deputy Williams charged with battery, aggravated assault and two counts of child abuse. |
