On 12/24/2020 at 1617 hours Deputy Patel responded to person. Dispatch advised a male, later identified as (V1), had armed himself with a kitchen knife and locked himself in the master bedroom. Dispatch stated the male was threatening to kill himself by stabbing himself. Dispatch also stated the male had a history of alcoholism and had been drinking since yesterday (12/23/2020).
Several other units responded and arrived on scene and began to secure the exterior of the residence. Deputy Baldwin made contact with the reporting party, (O1), and (O2), (O3), and (O4).

Shortly after then exited the residence where he was then secured in handcuffs without incident. was placed into protective custody under the provisions of the Baker Act.
