*****BWC RECORDING*****On 03/13/2020 at approximately 2003 hours Deputy Hyde responded to [REDACTED], Deltona FL in reference to a suicidal person. Prior to arriving on scene, deputies were advised via VCSO central dispatch the suicidal subject was threatening to kill herself using a gun. Central dispatch advised deputies the subjects sister, who lives in Casselberry, was speaking to the subject via telephone and the subject was indicating she was going to shoot herself. Additional deputies arrived on scene and a perimeter was established surrounding the subjects residence. Phone contact was made with [REDACTED] (RI), [REDACTED]s sister. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] called her crying and intoxicated. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] made every concerning statements that would indicate she was suicidal. [REDACTED] stated to [REDACTED] "I cant make anyone happy anymore. I cant take this anymore." [REDACTED] additionally stated to [REDACTED] "I should just shoot myself, you know I have a gun." [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] ended the conversation by stating "Goodbye, tell mom I love her." [REDACTED] completed a statement in her home city of Casselberry, Florida. A message was received from a Seminole County Sheriffs Deputy who made contact with [REDACTED] stating [REDACTED] meets Baker Act criteria. Deputies made contact with [REDACTED] (VI) who Deputy Hyde observed to be intoxicated. [REDACTED] stated she is not suicidal but did state to her sister on the phone that she "wants to just end it all." [REDACTED] advised there was a single handgun in her residence that she barely used inside of a lockbox in her bedroom. [REDACTED] refused to provide deputies with the location of the key for the lockbox. [REDACTED]s husband could not locate the key. [REDACTED]s husband also advised [REDACTED] had concealed weapons permit but could not locate that either. [REDACTED]s husband stated he would secure the firearm and lockbox and would keep it away from [REDACTED]. A hard copy property report for the firearms was completed and placed in the records box. A check of [REDACTED]s criminal history revealed no felony convictions. Based on the statements made by [REDACTED] to both [REDACTED] and deputies on scene, Deputy Hyde believes without proper care or treatment, there is a substantial likelihood [REDACTED] will cause serious bodily harm to herself in the near future. Based on that belief, Deputy Hyde placed [REDACTED] in custody under the authority of the Baker Act. During paperwork and transport, [REDACTED] stated to Deputy Hyde "I just want to die", "Just kill me now", and "Just shoot me in the head." Deputy Hyde completed a Risk Protection order which was later submitted to the RPO [REDACTED] was transported to Stewart Marchman ACT, Daytona Beach, Florida without incident. Case Status: Closed


