chamber thus making it readily accessible. The firearm was later submitted into district 3 south evidence
locker as evidence. Based on the totality of the circumstances, and all witness and evidence collected,
Deputy Hammond placed under arrest for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon as well as
possession/use of a firearm while under the influence of alcohol.
