Deputy Cowger and Deputy Armstrong arrived on scene and approached on foot towards the house. Once
at the house Deputy Cowger and Deputy Armstrong positioned themselves at the corner of the home
where they had a visual of the front door. Deputy Cowger was advised by Central Dispatch there were no
updates and it was assumed the male, later identified as was still armed. Central Dispatch then
advised the female, later identified as (V1), law enforcement was outside her home and
instructed her to exit. along with her son, (O1), began to exit the home, at which
began chasing after them. then exited the home and was given lawful commands by Deputy
Armstrong and Deputy Cowger to "get on the ground" which he refused to do. Based upon the
information given involving a firearm (which unknown if still in spossession) and the
immediately safety of along with Deputy Cowger deployed his department X26 Taser
(serial #X29007KN5). The first deployment stuck in his left arm with one probe and subsequently
the additional probe made no contact with still was not going to the ground and Deputy
Cowger redeployed the second cartridge from his Taser which stuck in the center mass of his
chest and stomach, causing him to go to the ground. It should be noted in CAD at 2356 hours, while
is still in contact with Central Dispatch Operators, they noted she stated "he's coming after me
now" as she was exiting her home and moments prior to Deputy Cowger's Taser deployment. Deputy
Armstrong secured in handcuffs.
Volusia County Fire Rescue respond to the scene and removed the Taser probes from item# 3.
Sergeant Ruiz arrived on scene and was made aware of what transpired prior to his arrival.
Deputy Cowger spoke with who advised the following: she was in a political discussion with
