I, *{full legal name}* DEPUTY LAWRENCE FEASTER 2010, in my position as *{job title}* deputy sheriff with the *{name of law enforcement officer/agency}* Volusia Sheriff's Office, swear and affirm that the following facts are true and correct.

1. *{Name of Respondent}* \_\_\_\_\_ poses a significant danger of causing personal injury to himself/herself or others by having a firearm or any ammunition in his/her custody or control or by purchasing, possessing or receiving a firearm or any ammunition. The following specific statements, actions, or facts give rise to a reasonable fear of significant dangerous acts by the respondent:

At approximately 1012 hours on May 26, 2022, Deputies Feaster and Hansard arrived at the residence of \_\_\_\_\_ in Port Orange in order to serve a writ of possession (eviction), pursuant to Volusia County court case number 2022 33083 COCI. \_\_\_\_\_ was to be evicted from the residence, which was to be placed into the possession of \_\_\_\_\_. Twenty-four hour eviction notices had been affixed to the front door on May 17 and May 25.

Both notices had been removed from the front door, presumably by [REDACTED]. The deputies were accompanied by the [REDACTED] who was also joined by a locksmith he retained. Deputy Feaster requested the assistance of Port Orange Police Department (POPD) officers, as it was believed [REDACTED] was still inside the home. [REDACTED] informed Deputy Hansard that [REDACTED] did not possess weapons and was not violent.

Deputy Feaster knocked on the front door of the residence multiple times and received no response. Deputy Hansard attempted to contact [REDACTED] via telephone, also receiving no response. The locksmith began working to unlock the deadbolt of the front door. After the door was unlocked, Deputy Feaster made loud, clear announcements of the presence of the Sheriff's Office and of the eviction. Deputy Feaster continued to loudly announce the presence of the Sheriff's Office as he checked the residence for any individuals. Both upstairs bedrooms were found to be locked. Deputy Feaster loudly announced the presence of the Sheriff's Office several times and knocked on the southeast bedroom door. He unlocked the southeast bedroom doorknob with using a small screwdriver. The southeast bedroom was found unoccupied.

Deputy Feaster announced the presence of the Sheriff's Office and of the eviction again. As Deputy Feaster worked to unlock the northeast bedroom door with the screwdriver, he again announced his presence and requested [REDACTED] open the door. Upon Deputy Feaster opening the bedroom door, he again announced "Sheriff's Office". Upon Deputy Feaster beginning to enter the bedroom and looking at the bed on the east side of the room, he immediately observed [REDACTED] laying on his back in the bed and facing Deputy Feaster. [REDACTED] was holding a black framed pistol having a silver color around the muzzle, with both arms extended and pointing the pistol directly at Deputy Feaster. Deputy Feaster notified Deputy Hansard and the POPD officers of the pistol and directed them to evacuate the home.

Upon descending the stairs and exiting the home, Deputy Feaster faced back into the front door to cover Deputy Hansard's and the officers' retreat through the front yard. [REDACTED] appeared at the top of the stairs with his right hand concealed by the hallway wall. Deputy Feaster ordered [REDACTED] to drop the pistol.

\_\_\_\_\_ spoke to Deputy Feaster, however his words could not be heard. \_\_\_\_\_ did not present or drop the pistol. Deputy Feaster retreated to his patrol vehicle to retrieve his rifle and to use the vehicle as cover.

Upon the arrival of POPD and Volusia Sheriff's Office SWAT teams, Deputy Feaster took no further enforcement actions until \_\_\_\_\_ finally exited the home and was arrested. \_\_\_\_\_ exited the home with a holstered and loaded SCCY Industries 9mm pistol. Deputy Feaster notified \_\_\_\_\_ that he is evicted from the home and he would be arrested, should he return. Deputy Feaster had no further interaction with \_\_\_\_\_. Deputy Feaster did not collect any evidence. Volusia Sheriff's Office investigators assumed the investigation and scene.
