Between 1700 hours to 1930 hours, sent multiple suicidal text messages to which included a message that he wanted to "blow his brains out". It also messaged the did not want to live anymore and sent a picture of a handgun on his lap. Was concerned for safety, and stated he had been depressed for the past few months. It filled out a sworn written statement about the incident. Took screen shots of the conversation to which she later emailed to Deputy Kapten's agency email. Deputy Kapten later uploaded the images to Digital Crime Scene Database.
With the facts and circumstances provided, deputies requested dispatch to ping the location of pickup truck was later observed by deputies traveling on towards his residence. Deputies performed a high-risk traffic stop of the vehicle. was the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle. was taken into protective custody under the Florida Baker Act. At the time of contact, was conceal carrying a Mossberg & Sons MC2 subcompact handgun bearing the serial number. The pistol was holstered in a waistband type carrier, with a spare magazine. Upon checking and clearing the weapon for safety, it was observed the firearm had a round loaded in the chamber. The pistol was checked through FCIC/NCIC which yielded negative results. The pistol, two magazines and 25 rounds of 9mm caliber ammunition were collected, packaged and submitted into the D3S Evidence Locker.
Deputies checked and confirmed that that has a valid Florida conceal weapon permit stated that he owned the following firearms in a safe in his bedroom: Faith B380 pistol, Mossberg 500 12-gauge, 250 rounds of 12 gauge, 9mm, .380, 7.62, and .22 caliber ammunition. advised he was the only person who had access to the safe which contained the firearms. signed a VSO Affidavit and Waiver Release of Liability form for to drive his vehicle home. Once arrived on scene, deputies advised her that was taken into protective custody under the Florida Baker Act. Due to the information provided by the stext messages indicating he wished to harm himself which included a picture of a firearm, and being located with a firearm on his person, Deputy Kapten completed all required Temporary Risk Protection Order paperwork signed for receipt of the surrendered pistol, two magazines, 25 rounds of ammunition and his concealed weapons permit. Was later transported to Halifax Health Hospital. This report was forwarded to VSO Legal advisor for review.
