I, *{full legal name}* Deputy Sheriff Oldham, in my position as *{job title}* Deputy Sheriff with the *{name of law enforcement officer/agency}* Volusia Sheriff's Office, swear and affirm that the following facts are true and correct.

1. *{Name of Respondent}* \_\_\_\_\_ poses a significant danger of causing personal injury to himself/herself or others by having a firearm or any ammunition in his/her custody or control or by purchasing, possessing or receiving a firearm or any ammunition. The following specific statements, actions, or facts give rise to a reasonable fear of significant dangerous acts by the respondent:

\*\*\* BWC RECORDING \*\*\*MARSY'S LAW INVOKED On 08/12/2022 at approximately 0628 hours, Deputies responded to \_\_\_\_\_ Deltona in reference to a disturbance. Prior to LEO arrival, central dispatch notified Deputies of a firearm being pointed at the reporting party. Deputies also observed the door to the office had signs of forced entry consistent with [REDACTED] s story. Deputies made contact with [REDACTED] who had previously been secured and was read his Miranda warning via a department issued Miranda warning card. [REDACTED] stated him and [REDACTED] got into a verbal argument in the living room of the house over him coming home too early. [REDACTED] stated after a verbal argument, he shoved [REDACTED] then proceeded to state he put his hands up and [REDACTED] walked into them. [REDACTED] proceeded to state [REDACTED] mentioned he was getting his firearm which [REDACTED] proceed upstairs to retrieve his but did not state that to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated he retrieved his firearm and put it in his waistband. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] followed [REDACTED] downstairs and stated [REDACTED] begged him to just go to work. [REDACTED] stated he walked down stairs (passing the exit to the residence) and confronted [REDACTED] at which point [REDACTED] pointed a gun at him. [REDACTED] stated he then moved his mother behind him in order to protect her from any harm. [REDACTED] stated he doesn't have a real gun but a revolver BB gun which he threw into his dirty laundry basket. Deputies made contact with [REDACTED] who stated she awoke to [REDACTED] slamming his door for which she called [REDACTED] into the room and observed what appeared to be a gun in his waistband. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] informed her that [REDACTED] had a gun and to go back inside her room and hide. [REDACTED] stated she observed an object in [REDACTED] s hand but could not tell Deputies what it was exactly. [REDACTED] stated she stated to [REDACTED] several times to just leave and go to work for which she stated [REDACTED] did not listen. [REDACTED] stated he did not witness anyone point any firearms but did witness [REDACTED] with a firearm. Deputies observed the stairwell leading to the front doorway of the residence and the office in the back of the house. After completing his investigation, Deputy Oldham determined [REDACTED] was the primary aggressor and that he made no effort the leave the residence after passing

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the exit to the residence to confront \_\_\_\_\_ in his office to the rear of the residence and actually and intentionally struck \_\_\_\_\_ against his will. Additionally, during the incident \_\_\_\_\_ was armed with a BB-gun which he pointed at \_\_\_\_\_ making him believe it was a real firearm. \_\_\_\_\_ gave consent to search his room for the BB gun which Deputies located in the dirty laundry basket. Deputy Oldham submitted the firearm into the district 4 evidence locker. \_\_\_\_\_ completed a sworn written statement of the incident to the best of his knowledge and stated he wished to pursue criminal charges. \_\_\_\_\_ was supplied with a Domestic Violence victims rights and remedies brochure. \_\_\_\_\_ completed a sworn verbal statement recounting the incident to the best of her knowledge. A Risk Protection Order was filed against \_\_\_\_\_ was transported to the Volusia County Branch Jail without incident.


