The following specific statements, actions, or facts give rise to a reasonable fear of significant dangerous acts by the respondent:

Upon arrival Deputies could hear yelling inside the residence and a female crying. While Deputies were listening before making contact, Central dispatch advised another half of the same

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disturbance was at the Winn Dixie in Debarry alleging his brother "pistol whipped" him. Deputy Igo requested another unit to make contact with that party while he was still at the _____ address. A male could be heard inside of the residence yelling about his firearm being taken. As it sounded like the argument could be escalating contact was made at the front door of the residence with a male. The male was identified as _____ (D1) and he advised he was engaged in a physical altercation with his brother, who was later identified as _____ (V1). _____ was initially being evasive with his responses and was not forthcoming with information about who else was inside the residence along with their condition. _____ was then detained while the investigation continued. At that point _____ yelled out to his girlfriend inside who exited the residence and made contact with deputy Igo. The female was identified as _____ (W2) and permitted Deputy Igo to enter the residence to check on all parties. _____ advised her son was inside his room asleep and did not witness the altercation outside between the brothers. _____ went on to advised she was notified by _____ that he was in a fight with _____ so she stepped outside to intervene but did not witness any firearms. _____ then left the residence with his wife and _____ escorted _____ back inside their residence. Deputy Igo collected a sworn written statement from _____ Deputy Igo then made contact with Deputy James who was at the Winn Dixie location with two people who he identified as _____ (V1) and _____ (W2). Deputy James advised _____ stated he was engaged in an argument with his brother _____ which escalated causing _____ to punch _____ and _____ then fighting back. _____ gained the upper hand in the fight and then disengaged. _____ then proceeded to go inside his residence and obtain his firearm and came back outside pointing the firearm at _____. _____ then proceeded to attack _____ by striking him with the firearm and _____ then wrestled it away from him. _____ then retained possession of the firearm and left the scene to contact law enforcement. _____ sustained multiple lacerations and contusions from the attack and was treated by EVAC for his injuries but refused transport. _____ corroborated _____'s depiction of the incident. A sworn written statement was collected from _____ and _____ swore to his verbal statement on body worn camera. Deputy James collected the firearm used in the altercation and ran the serial number on teletype which yielded negative results. _____ was then placed under arrest for domestic violence with aggravated assault and battery. Digital photographs were taken of _____ and _____ and were later submitted the digital crime scene database. _____ was provided with his victim's rights and remedies pamphlet which also contained the case number.

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A domestic violence information sheet and victim notification card were completed. [REDACTED] invoked his right to keep his information private per Marsy's law which was reflected on the appropriate form. [REDACTED] was then transported to the District 6 office where the necessary paperwork was completed. A criminal history was requested for [REDACTED] which only showed one misdemeanor conviction. The firearm, magazine, and ammunition was made safe and entered into the district 6 evidence locker as evidence. It should be noted the firearm appeared to have a dried red substance on it's exterior which appeared to be dried blood. [REDACTED] was then transported to VCBJ without incident. A risk protection order affidavit was completed.
