On September 25, 2022, at approximately 2109 hours, Deputy White responded to DeLand in reference to a disturbance.
While en route to the location, Volusia Sheriff's Office communications advised the disturbance
at the location involved a firearm. Due to the nature of the incident, Deputy White staged at the
intersection of 1st Av/ Oleander Rd. for additional units to arrive for assistance.
While staged at the intersection, Deputy White observed two male subjects, later identified as
(V1) and (V2) riding their bicycles towards the intersection.
and both discovered Deputy White and made contact with him.
Once contact was made, and stated the following information:
stated while he was at the residence, he observed (D1), who is the
property owner arrive and pointed a firearm at (V3), while he stated he was going
to shoot him in the face if he did not get the dog that bit him earlier. however refused to
retrieve the dog for
further advised while was at the residence, he made threats to everyone, including
him that he would shoot them in the face if they got in the way.
When Deputy White asked further descriptive features about the firearm,
explained the firearm appeared to be a black semi-automatic pistol.
further explained that although
was making the threats to shoot everyone, he was in fear of his life due to
active physical control of the firearm.
also believed would have carried out the act of shooting anyone that got in his way.
also completed a Marsys' Law to Confidentiality form and wished to keep his personal
information public.
Deputy White then made contact with who stated arrived at the residence and
approached the front porch area. Upon arrival, asked where the dog was at.
then threatened that if he did not tell him where the dog was at, he would shoot
in the face. Solution later proceeded where he believed the dog was located.
While was at the residence, advised was in possession of a black colored
semi-automatic pistol.

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also mentioned that although did not point the firearm at him directly, he was in fear for his life due to the threats being made by him.
also believed would have carried out the act of shooting anyone that got in his
way.
completed a sworn written statement in reference to the incident and wished to pursue
criminal charges. also completed a Marsys' Law to Confidentiality form and wished to
keep his personal information public.
Once Deputies obtained the information from and and they began to tactically
approach the residence due to the fact that it was still unknown if
Upon arrival, Deputies made contact with outside the residence who stated the following
information.
stated while was at the residence working, he believed was bitten by the dog
due to seeing blood spots throughout the driveway and pool deck area.
later returned to the residence, with what described to be chrome pistol.
informed that the dog was done tonight
further stated once informed him he was going to kill the dog, pointed the
pistol at him while holding it with both hands.
dog that attacked him.
later proceeded to (V4) bedroom.
When Deputy White questioned if was in fear for his life during the incident,
advised he was and also believed would have carried out the act of causing harm.
completed a sworn written statement in reference to the incident and wished to pursue
criminal charges. also completed a Marsys' Law to Confidentiality form and wished to
keep his personal information private.

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Deputies then made contact with who advised while he was inside his bedroom, he
began to hear several loud knocks at his bedroom door.
and while doing so, he observed pointing a chrome pistol at his face and demanded to
know where the dog that bit him was at.
During the incident, entered into s bedroom to locate the dog, but was met with
negative results and later vacated the residence.
When questioned on how felt about the incident, advised he was indeed in fear
for his life due to pointing a firearm at him.
completed a sworn written statement in reference to the incident and wished to pursue
criminal charges. It is also completed a Marsy's Law to Confidentiality form and wished to
keep his personal information private.
While on scene, Deputy White observed several blood drops throughout the driveway and pool
deck area. Deputy White collected digital photographs of the blood spots which were later
uploaded to the digital crime scene database.
It should be noted, the incident involving was non domestic violence related due to
not being related by blood or marriage to any of the victims involved.
also did not actually discharge the firearm during the incident, nor did he strike anyone.
also is the listed property owner of the residence and all the victims involved are only his
tenants.
Deputies later arrived at seridence, located at DeLand to make
contact.
Upon arrival, Deputies made contact with who initially did not wish to exit his residence
at first but later complied with Deputies.
When questioned about the incident, stated while he was at the Oleander residence
working, he was bitten by the tenant's dog, which caused significant damage to his right hand.
o. The right hand.

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later left the residence to get medical assistance for his injury. Then returned to the residence, to which a disturbance ensued between himself and the tenants. When asked if he was in possession of a firearm during the incident denied being in possession of a firearm and claimed he does not currently own any. It should be noted, during the interview appeared to be under the influence of an intoxicating substance. The also admitted he had been drinking.
also did not go into great detail on the reason why he returned to the residence where he was attacked at by the dog.
Based on the information, Deputy White developed probable cause to charge with four counts of Aggravated Assault (FSS:784.021).
vas subsequently taken into custody due to the charges. Deputy Childs read this Constitutinal rights via a Volusia Sheriff's Office Miranda Warning card, however did not wish to speak to Deputies any further about the incident. Due to the incident involving a firearm, Deputy White completed a Risk Protection Order. A criminal history check revealed to have prior arrests for felony battery. was later transported to the Volusia County Branch Jail, located in Daytona Beach.
