access to numerous firearms within the residence, and he put on an armored tactical vest.  then stated she could hear loading ammunition into magazines. left the residence and made contact with law enforcement at Fleming Avenue and S. Nova Road.							
District 3 North deputies, along with officers of the Ormond Beach and Holly Hill Police Departments converged in the area. Deputy Wilson proceeded northound on a parked his patrol vehicle approximately 120 yards from some some residence. Deputy Wilson was unable to see the residence, but could see vehicle brake lights illuminating. Deputy Wilson observed a black pickup truck reverse out of the driveway, and begin driving southbound on towards Deputy Wilson. The vehicle stopped, reversed, and parked back in the driveway. Sergeant Turner authorized the use of Stop-Sticks if the vehicle attempted to leave again. Moments later, the vehicle began driving southbound on and Deputy Wilson successfully deployed Stop-Sticks in the path of the vehicle. The vehicle came to an abrupt stop, and quickly exited. was wearing a black, armored tactical vest with several rifle magazines attached, and had a black handgun holstered on the inside of his right waistband. Deputy Wilson, Deputy Carelli, and several officers from the aforementioned police departments drew their firearms and pointed them at while giving commands. immediately laid on the ground in a prone position and surrendered. was taken into custody without further incident.							
Deputy Wilson read this Miranda Rights, which he verbally stated he understood. Stated he and the were going through relationship issues, and he took one and a half prescribed Xanax pills. Stated he was going to "eat his glock" which means he was going to commit suicide by shooting himself in the head.							
Based on deputies conversation with the second it was determined no crime had occurred.  vas subsequently taken into protective custody under the Baker Act statute, due to the likelihood would suffer from self-harm without the immediate intervention of a licensed physician.
