1. *{Name of Respondent}* _____ poses a significant danger of causing personal injury to himself/herself or others by having a firearm or any ammunition in his/her custody or control or by purchasing, possessing or receiving a firearm or any ammunition. The following specific statements, actions, or facts give rise to a reasonable fear of significant dangerous acts by the respondent:

On 10/27/2022 at approximately 0843 hours, Deputy Curtin arrived on scene at _____ DeLeon Springs, in reference to a suspicious person. Deputy Curtin made contact with a neighbor who advised they saw a female with a young girl walking in the roadway carrying a sledgehammer and a young girl was with her. The neighbor advised she saw the adult female laying in the roadway at one point. Deputy Curtin approached the residence and observed on the windshield of a car outside was a

Deputy Curtin then made contact with _____ (VI) and _____ (O1) inside the residence. Deputy Curtin observed _____ to have a large contusion under her left eye and a laceration on her lips. _____ appeared to be okay and no obvious marks or bruises were observed. When Deputy Curtin spoke with _____ she was very distraught, paranoid and unable to sit still. Deputy Curtin asked _____ why she layed in the roadway and she replied that there were guards dressed in all black who told her too but then when asked to clarify advised _____ had to pee so _____ layed down in the roadway. Deputy Curtin asked why _____ had a sledgehammer to which she replied it was for protection. Deputy Curtin asked _____ how the contusion and laceration on her face happened to which she said the laceration was a fever blister and the contusion is from her punching herself in the face approximately a week ago. Deputy Curtin asked if _____ was supposed to take any medication to which she advised yes but stop taking them due to side effects and they were for voices in her head. Deputy Curtin asked if _____ was currently having any suicidal thoughts and she advised she has in the past but not right now.

Deputy Curtin determined based on the totality of the circumstances there was a substantial likelihood that within the near future _____ would cause serious bodily harm to herself or others _____ as evident by recent behavior. _____ was subsequently taken into protective custody and placed under a Baker Act. _____ was later transported to SMA. Carla Quann was notified of the incident due to the involvement of a juvenile. Deputies contacted DCF and spoke with Shanbrea 355 who advised she would be responding. Deputies made contact with the grandfather of _____ who was later identified as _____ (O2). _____ was the only biological family that deputies were able to make contact with, so he took he took temporary custody of _____ (pending DCF's investigation). Deputies later turned over _____'s shotgun into _____'s possession. Due to _____'s altered mental state, possible untreated mental illness, and not properly securing her firearm/ being responsible for its whereabouts, Deputies forwarded an RPO (risk protection order) to the Volusia Sheriff's Office attorney for review.
