On 11/12/22 at approximately 2345 hours, Deputies were dispatched to an assault on Interstate 4 (I-4) near mile marker 107, Deltona. While en route, Deputies were advised by Central Communications a subject pointed a firearm with a green laser, at the reporting person, (V1) while driving along I-4. Deputies were advised the vehicle entered Deltona from the eastbound exit 114.
Deputies canvassed the area and located a gray Toyota Corolla bearing Florida tag: The vehicle traveled eastbound on Howland Boulevard until it turned northbound onto Catalina Boulevard. The vehicle then traveled southbound on Lake Helen Osteen Road until Deputies conducted a felony traffic stop.
Deputies contacted the driver, (D1) and his fiancee, (W1). was read his Miranda warnings via an agency issued card which he indicated he understood.
Upon arrival, Deputy Branstiter spoke with and were traveling eastbound in the furthest left lane on I-4 in the Altamonte Springs area. In noticed a black lifted pickup approaching at high speed from the rear. The pickup began flashing its high beams at seven to switch lanes and was followed by the vehicle, driven by who continued to tailgate seven to pull up beside him on the left side of his vehicle. It is when allowed to pull up beside him on the left side of his vehicle. Waved his finger at an allowed waved his finger at admits to having in his right hand a black portable, handheld radio for communication with friends while driving states that the radio has a green light on the front that flashes green when not in use and red when in use. The finger waving continued for a couple of minutes until pulled off at exit 111. Continued until exiting at 114 to head for his residence in Deltona.

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was contacted and read her Miranda warnings via an agency issued card which she also indicated she understood. initially declined to speak with law enforcement, but later disclosed there was a road rage incident along I-4. denied displayed his firearm during the incident.
Deputies contacted at the RaceTrac gas station located at 407 Deltona Blvd, Deltona who stated the following:
He was driving eastbound on I-4 and 2 cars were driving slow blocking traffic. said he went around them and they caught back up with him. said the two vehicles tried to block him in and it became a road rage incident. said the silver Toyota went into the right lane and he observed the driver wave a gun out of the window. Had described the driver as a Hispanic male with tattoos.
completed a sworn written statement wishing to pursue criminal charges.
Deputy Branstiter observed the following recording:
The silver Toyota is observed driving in the right lane. The driver waves his arm out of the window. The driver repeats the same action a second time. The driver extends his arm for a third time and extends his arm further out toward the sky.
Deputies obtained a video recording of the incident which was later submitted into evidence.
Deputies observed a black handgun (s/n: see the driver seat and center console. It is seen to locate the green laser. Deputies did not locate any laser emitting device. The handgun owned which was holstered and tucked between the driver-side seat and center console was not equipped with any type of laser emitting device.
