Upon arrival, Deputy Barry made contact with (V1) who explained she Additional pages are attached. 2. {Name of Witness} provided the following information based on his/her personal knowledge: an unknown male(later identified as on a red motorcycle wearing a red jacket and black helmet cut them off and moments later noticed the unknown male reach into the lower left portion of his jacket and remove a black firearm and point the firearm at her from underneath his armpit. noted she feared for her safety at this point and made her husband, who was reclined in the front passenger seat, aware of the incident.

mentioned she continued traveling Northbound behind the motorcycle and when they approached the light at East New York Avenue and South Kepler, the male on the motorcycle got off of the motorcycle, approached the front of the vehicle and struck the hood and front windshield of the vehicle with his fists, subsequently causing the front windshield to crack. After striking the windshield, the male got on his motorcycle, ran the red light at the intersection and continued to travel Northbound. When describing the firearm, Deputy Barry's duty pistol but could not expand further. Sestimated the damage caused to his windshield to be approximately \$400.00 in value. Completed a sworn written statement detailing the incident, which he noted he wished to pursue criminal charges.

While reviewing the photograph, Deputy Barry noticed the operator of the motorcycle was wearing a black helmet, which appeared to cover the entirety of the head, a red windbreaker style jacket, which was blue from the left to right shoulder and upper back, black long pants and the motorcycle to be red and white. Deputy Barry further noticed a black backpack secured to the motorcycle above the break light. The license plate was partially visible in the photograph, but despite Deputy Barry's efforts, he was unable to read the tag because of the distance of the motorcycle in the picture. A copy of the photograph provided by and photographs of the damage caused to see which we have provided to the digital crime scene database.
