

Through Deputy Peas' investigation it was determined there would be a substantial likelihood that without the proper care or treatment, would likely cause serious bodily harm to himself. was taken into protective custody under the Baker Act and was later transported Halifax Hospital for treatment.
Due to the statements made by and the access to firearms at the residence, a risk protection order was completed by Deputy Peas and forwarded to Volusia Sheriff's Office Legal Advisor.
