Upon arrival, Deputy Campbell observed and in the front yard of the residence immediately placed both of his hands in the air upon sight of law enforcement, and was subsequently secured in handcuffs. Was then checked for weapons which was met with negative result. Deputy Campbell attempted to interview as to the reason law enforcement had be summoned to the residence. Stated he and mad been arguing but would not elaborate on the topic. When further questioned about arming himself with a firearm and making statements eluding to ending his life, shrugged his shoulders and refused to answer.
