Marsy's Law Invoked

On 06/26/2023 at approximately 0509 hours, Deputy Blissett responded to [REDACTED] Deltona in reference to a disturbance involving a firearm.

Prior to arrival, Central Dispatch advised the following information:

The reporting person, later identified as [REDACTED] (R1), advised he received a phone call from his friend, later identified as [REDACTED] (V1), stating that shortly after he dropped her off at the aforementioned address, her fiancé put a gun to her head. [REDACTED] returned to the residence and was confronted by [REDACTED]'s fiancé, later identified as [REDACTED] (D1) with the firearm. [REDACTED] advised he then left the residence and reported the incident to Law Enforcement. [REDACTED] stated he would not meet with Law Enforcement; however, Law Enforcement can call him if needed.

While enroute to the location of the incident, Deputy Blissett observed a female walking near the intersection of Saxon Boulevard and North Kingway Drive, located down the road from the location of the incident. Deputy Blissett met with [REDACTED] who provided the following information:

[REDACTED] works as a bar tender at Bull Dog bar located in Deltona. [REDACTED] had to stay late at work to finish up paperwork. Due to [REDACTED] not allowing [REDACTED] to utilize his truck, [REDACTED] no way of returning home. [REDACTED] had [REDACTED] who is the DJ at the bar where she works, give her a ride home. Upon returning to inside the residence, [REDACTED] approached her asking where she was and with who she was with. This escalated into a verbal argument. [REDACTED] then demanded for [REDACTED]'s phone. [REDACTED] denied his request and kept it away from him. [REDACTED] grabbed [REDACTED] and forcefully pushed her to the ground in an attempt to obtain her phone. While on top of [REDACTED], [REDACTED] forcefully had to pry the phone from [REDACTED]'s hand. [REDACTED] then went through her phone and discovered a female name that [REDACTED] been texting and calling on the night of the incident. [REDACTED] then called the number and realized it was in fact not a female, but [REDACTED]'s co-worker, [REDACTED] who answered the phone. After numerous attempts to obtain her phone back from [REDACTED], [REDACTED] finally received her phone back. [REDACTED] then left the residence and called

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██████████ then left the residence and called ██████████ to come back and pick her up. ██████████ waited in the front yard for ██████████'s arrival. ██████████ later arrived on scene to pick ██████████ up. Once on scene, ██████████ walked out of the residence and confronted ██████████ and ██████████ accusing her of cheating and ██████████ of having sexual intercourse with his fiancé. ██████████ advised when ██████████ confronted ██████████ and herself, he had a handgun in his waistband. At one point during the confrontation, ██████████ pulled the gun out and was waving it around while in a verbal altercation with ██████████ and ██████████. Due to ██████████ not wanting to be involved, ██████████ left ██████████ and ██████████ then left the residence and began walking towards Saxon Boulevard feeling like she had no where to go. ██████████ noted ██████████ and herself have 2 children in common that were currently staying in Palm Coast with ██████████'s mother ██████████ and ██████████ engaged and have been together for approximately 4 years. ██████████ refused to complete a sworn written statement; however, did swear to a verbal statement instead.

It should be noted that while speaking with ██████████, ██████████ was visibly upset and crying because of the incident. ██████████ advised she did not want tell all the truth due getting ██████████ in trouble. When interviewing ██████████ about the firearm, ██████████ continuously hesitated with her answers and would continuously shake. When asked if she was in fear, ██████████ advised she was began crying. ██████████ noted that this was not the first time ██████████ had physical/mentally hurt her. When asked if the gun was ever to her head, ██████████ denied the accusation. During the entire course of the interview, ██████████ was uncooperative in giving details of what happened and was crying. Deputy Blissett observed no physical injuries to ██████████'s person.

Deputy Gourley contacted ██████████ who advised the following information:  
On the night of the incident, ██████████ dropped ██████████ off at her residence and left. A short time later, he received a phone call from ██████████ who was crying hysterically. ██████████ told ██████████ that ██████████ held a gun up to her head and they were in a physical altercation. ██████████ requested he come and pick her up. ██████████ later arrived back at the residence. ██████████ advised he did not witness any of the altercation; however, ██████████ did observe ██████████ come out of the residence with a handgun in his waistband. Due to observing this, ██████████ did not want to become involved and left the residence. ██████████ later contacted Law Enforcement to report the incident. ██████████ did not want to complete a sworn written statement. ██████████ did swear to his verbal statement over the phone.

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Deputies later arrived at the residence and spoke with ██████████ about the incident. While speaking to Deputies about the incident and without direct questioning, ██████████ stated he did take ██████████'s phone from her. Deputies placed ██████████ under arrest. Deputy Slover advised ██████████ of his constitutional rights via agency issued Miranda Warning card. ██████████ acknowledged his rights, waived them and wanted to speak to Deputy Slover. ██████████ provided the following information: ██████████ had a feeling that ██████████ stayed late after work because she was cheating on him. Upon ██████████ arrival home, ██████████ and ██████████ ensued in a verbal argument due to her coming home late and having another male drop her off at him. ██████████ then took her phone and observed a female name in her phone that turned out to be ██████████. When asked about the handgun, ██████████ advised it was a S&W 380 Bodyguard and he did not have CCW. ██████████ advised he did not have it on him when he took the phone from ██████████. When ██████████ arrived at the residence, ██████████ did admit he confronted ██████████ and ██████████ in the driveway of the residence with the handgun in his waistband. Due to not having it properly secured in his pants, the gun began to slide down his pants. ██████████ then grabbed the gun in order to keep it from falling down his pants leg while still in a verbal altercation with ██████████. During the interview, ██████████ stated he did not want to speak about the incident any further and requested he have a lawyer.

Deputy Blissett provided ██████████ with a Domestic Violence Legal Rights and Remedies which she signed for. Deputy Blissett completed a Domestic Violence packet and provided ██████████ with a VSO Business card with case number attached.

Deputy Blissett asked ██████████ if Deputies could obtain the firearm from the home; in which, she denied such request.

Deputy Blissett later completed an RPO for ██████████ due to the incident involving a firearm.

██████████ was later transported to the VCBJ without incident.


