On 07/21/2023, at approximately 2226 hours, Deputy Delarosa responded to New Smyrna Beach, in reference to a weapons complaint.
Prior to Deputy Delarosa's arrival Sergeant J. Turner requested for mutual aid. Officer K. Nugeri and Officer P. Sweeny with the Edgewater Police Department arrived on scene and made contact with (S1). Prior to their arrival the Edgewater officer's made contact with bystanders who advised they heard several gunshots coming from strailer. For more details refer to Edgewater Police Departments Case number EW230700170.
Upon arrival, Deputy Delarosa made contact Deputy Delarosa read Rights from his agency issued card. Advised he understood his rights and wished to speak with deputies.
advised the following: had been drinking and was in a "good mood". had recently bought a Glock 23 and wanted to test it out. stated that he walked from within his residence to his doorway and fired the handgun outside in the air towards Oak Hill, because it's known as "Pill Hill" approximately 9 times. Deputy Delarosa asked for his consent to recover the aforementioned firearm, along with a Ruger Assault Rifle from within the residence to which replied yes. Deputy Delarosa recovered a black handgun in the rear of the residence, unloaded with no ammunition, and a black Ruger Assault Rifle encased located inside a closet in the bedroom of the residence. Deputies gathered photographs of the scene along with loose shell casing that were on scene by the doorway. Deputies recovered 9, 9MM shell casing that were later gathered as evidence.
While on scene deputies canvased the area, deputies were unable to locate surveillance cameras. Deputies made contact with (O1). advised he heard gunshots from outside his residence, and when went to look outside he saw with a Semi-automatic handgun facing away from his camper by his porch.
Due to the high propensity of recklessly discharging any more weapons, were seized as evidence and RPO'ed. It should be noted Glock handgun, was taken for evidence purposes and his Rugar Assault Rifle was taken under a Risk Protection Order.
