was scouting the area for roof sales and approached the victim, He agreed to talk to but did not want to hear his sales pitch. It then asked for information about the neighbors and became rude stating he isn't giving out any personal information even if he knew it and responded by calling him rude and walking away. asked "wanna see rude i will show you rude" and began to yell at property or he would "beat his ass". The put his left hand in his pocket and grabbed on to his fireman and partially pulled it out, brandishing it so could see it in an attempt to scare him. Due to prior military experiences, he stepped up to the challenge and began to verbally berated and got in his face. The then pushed him back and pulled his firearm out and pointed at chest. I did not back down and followed him to his car. followed him around the car refusing to let him leave until law enforcement arrival.
advised he did pull his firearm out on when the verbal argument ensued. He stated it was because he wanted him to leave him alone not because he was in fear for his life. He advised he tried to leave the area but was standing on scene upon law enforcement arrival.
dvised he became irritated when he told him to leave the property and he began to talk back. confronted him after seeing the firearm in his hand and told him "I'm not scared shoot me! pull the trigger I dare you". did admit to not allowing to get in his car and leave until law enforcement arrives. an independent witness, advise she watched the entire confrontation and could have left at any time instead he chose to stand toe to toe with not showing any fear and standing his ground at the end of striveway. did not see the firearm displayed but did see everything that ensued. Through Deputies investigation, statements collected, and firearm observed it was determined that the placed under arrest for Aggravated assault with a firearm without intent to kill for brandishing a concealed firearm and pointing it at during a verbal argument without any fear of death or bodily harm.
