received a phone call from another mutual friend, who was later identified as (O1). It is wife answered the phone call on speaker in the presence of informed that she received a phone call from stating that was at the residence with her and had been beating her again. It had his wife call on speakerphone to see if was okay and find out more details. While was speaking to the phone, residence on Saturday, November 11, 2023, after staying with his parents for a while. Stated she and had been arguing about getting divorced and had been beating while staying at their residence. Stated at one point during their arguments on Saturday. In had brandished a revolver and pointed it at the shead, which put in even more fear of the phone and that the sounded very "drunk" while speaking to him on the phone and that have an extensive history of alcohol abuse.

Deputy Cusimano tolo at the residence, due to the nature of the allegations. While Deputy Cusimano was approaching the front gate to the property, Deputy Cusimano heard a loud, single gun shot, which appeared to have come from the front of the residence. Deputy Cusimano updated Central Dispatch with this information and began to approach the residence. After Deputy Cusimano cleared a makeshift shed and shop building on the northwest corner of the property, Deputy Cusimano approached the front of the residence with his department issued handgun drawn. Deputy Cusimano took cover behind a tree located between the shop building and the residence and observed with his hands on his lap. Deputy Cusimano identified himself as a Sheriff's Deputy and gave loud verbal commands to complied with Deputy Cusimano's verbal commands and was ultimately ordered to lay down in the front yard on his stomach, until additional deputies arrived on scene. Sergeant Mather and Sergeant Webster arrived on scene shortly after, Sergeant Mather secured with handcuffs. Deputy Cusimano and Sergeant Mather approached the front of the residence, Deputy Cusimano observed a large silver revolver sitting on a side table, directly next to where was sitting on the front porch.
Deputy Cusimano and Sergeant Mather gave loud verbal announcements at the front door of the residence, identifying themselves as Sheriff's Deputies, and called out for Cusimano heard respond, at which point stated she was upstairs. Deputy Cusimano cleared the interior of the residence for any outstanding subjects and ultimately made contact with stated she was upstairs master bedroom. Was lying in her bed and was crying. Deputy Cusimano asked what happened, but was very emotional and had slurred speech. Eventually showed Deputy Cusimano bruises on her right forearm and wrist stating had caused them continued crying and did not provide any more information to the Deputies at this time. Sergeant Mather requested Central Dispatch to see if a female Officer was available to come and attempt speaking with Deputy Cusimano asked if she would like paramedics to respond and evaluate her injuries to which declined.

Deputy Cusimano returned to where was located in the front yard and read Miranda Rights, utilizing a department issued Miranda card stated he understood his Miranda Rights and that with the rights in mind he still wished to speak to Deputy Cusimano. Deputy Cusimano asked what had happened, and kept staying "It's her parents" referring to sparents. Rept repeating this statement and would only give vague answers to questions and had notably slurred speech. Stated he and had recently been arguing about divorcing one another and that was staying with his parents temporarily in Port Orange. Came back to the house to stay with Saturday, November 11, 2023, and had been arguing back and forth with since then. Deputy Cusimano escorted to his patrol vehicle to sit down inside of it, out of the rain and continue interviewing stated last night, November 13, 2023, he told he wanted a divorce, at which point cheek with a closed fist. Deputy Cusimano examined be wanted a divorce, at which point cheek with a closed fist. Deputy Cusimano examined stated "nothing". Walked away from and began to drink "Vodka" until he fell asleep on the couch in the living room. Deputy Cusimano asked how got the bruises on her arms and wrists, to which replied, "Because she's a bitch". In denied putting his hand on less than cooperative with providing more details about the argument.
Deputy Cusimano asked why he was sitting on the front porch of the residence with his revolver stated he was "pissed" and shot a single round from the revolver into the front lawn out of anger. Stated he did not point the firearm at anybody, and his intent was not to harm anyone with the firearm. Deputy Cusimano asked retrieves a firearm when he is upset, and replied asking Deputy Cusimano what does he do when he is upset.

It should be noted that while Deputy Cusimano was speaking with a strong odor of alcohol kept emanating from s mouth and the odor got stronger the more spoke. While walking and needed assistance balancing by Deputy Cusimano and Sergeant Webster. See eyes were also glassy and bloodshot. That a very large range of emotions while in contact with Deputy Cusimano, which varied from crying hysterically to randomly laughing to himself. Based on the totality of the circumstances along with statements, it was evident to Deputy Cusimano that was under the influence of alcohol, based on Deputy Cusimano's training and experience also admitted that he had been taking anti-depressant medications while consuming alcohol.
While completing this report, Deputy Cusimano asked why he pointed his revolver at on Saturday, November 11, 2023. Stated pushed to his "breaking point" after allegedly punched him in the face during an argument kept bringing up her parents during the argument, which further agitated stated he retrieved his revolver from his gun safe, approached revolver at her face, and stated he was tired of hitting him.
Deputy Cusimano was provided 6 digital photographs documenting also had a very large bruise on her left tricep near her elbow. Deputy Cusimano uploaded the digital photographs to Digital Crime Scene.
did not wish to provide a sworn written statement to deputies on scene. did state verbally to deputies that she was in fear of when he pointed the revolver at her face during their argument on Saturday, November 11, 2023 also stated was responsible for the bruises on her arms and wrists, due to hitting and grabbing her against her will. Sergeant Mather asked if she swore and affirmed that her verbal statements were true, to which replied she did.
completed a Marsy's Law form requesting that her information not be made public.

Deputy Becker collected the revolver and submitted it into evidence. Deputy Becker completed a

supplement report for his involvement.
