I, {full legal name} JUSTON SCHRAMM, in my position as {job title} DEPUTY with the {name of law enforcement officer/agency} VOLUSIA SHERIFF OFFICE, swear and affirm that the following facts are true and correct.

1. {Name of Respondent} _____ poses a significant danger of causing personal injury to himself/herself or others by having a firearm or any ammunition in his/her custody or control or by purchasing, possessing or receiving a firearm or any ammunition. The following specific statements, actions, or facts give rise to a reasonable fear of significant dangerous acts by the respondent:

On 11/26/2023 at 0857 hours Deputy Schramm was dispatched to _____ in reference to a suicidal person. According to dispatch notes, _____ (W1), and his mother, _____ (W2), had left the residence and requested Law Enforcement meet with them at _____ North Woodland Boulevard. The notes continued with a known subject, _____ (S1), who had locked herself in a room of the house screaming that she was going to end her life with a firearm and had access to

[REDACTED] stated the first incident happened on 11/25/23 when he was woken up by [REDACTED] screaming at him. [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] accused him of cheating on her and was "losing her mind." [REDACTED] stated they separated for the night and at approximately 0750 hours on 11/26/23 the argument happened again. [REDACTED] advised during the argument [REDACTED] had stated several times that she would end her life with a firearm. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] then locked herself in the bedroom that contained the firearms and refused to open the door. [REDACTED] stated that he did not see a firearm in [REDACTED] possession but could hear her messing around with them. [REDACTED] recorded a video of [REDACTED] screaming in the bedroom. [REDACTED] also recorded a video of [REDACTED] racking a round" of a firearm then saying "There is a real bullet in this one." [REDACTED] advised he left the residence to contact Law Enforcement. [REDACTED] provided Deputies with a sworn written statement and copies of the video. Deputy Schramm asked [REDACTED] if there was anyone else in the residence and he stated no. Deputy Schramm asked [REDACTED] if he knew how many firearms and what type of firearms were in the residence and he stated approximately 15 firearms varying from AR-15s, shotguns, and pistols. [REDACTED] also confirmed that all the firearms in the residence belonged to him. Deputy Schramm then made contact with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated on 11/25/23 [REDACTED] had texted her stating she needed to talk to her about [REDACTED] advised she called [REDACTED] and that [REDACTED] started cursing, screaming, and crying because [REDACTED] cheated on her. [REDACTED] stated that she listened to [REDACTED] then suggested that she stay with family until things calmed down. [REDACTED] advised that things continued to escalate when [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that she wanted to kill herself. [REDACTED] provided the Deputies with a sworn written statement. Deputies arrived at [REDACTED] and contacted [REDACTED] via cellphone. Deputies were successfully able to convince [REDACTED] to leave the residence and approach deputies. Deputy Schramm placed handcuffs on [REDACTED] as Deputies escorted [REDACTED] to a marked patrol vehicle. [REDACTED] stated to Deputies that she was extremely upset about [REDACTED] cheating on her and the ending of the relationship. [REDACTED] advised that she did mention wanting to kill herself with a firearm during an argument with [REDACTED] on 11/26/23. [REDACTED] stated that she doesn't own any firearms and doesn't know what firearm she picked up. [REDACTED] stated that she contacted family to come to the residence after [REDACTED] had left to help console her then Law Enforcement arrived to the residence. The digital video that [REDACTED] provided was uploaded to Digital Crime Scene. Deputies also took digital images of the firearms in the residence and uploaded them to Digital Crime Scene. Due to the weapons belonging to [REDACTED] all firearms inside the residence were left in his possession.


