I, {full legal name} Raymond Kalmar, in my position as {job title} Deputy Sheriff with the {name of law enforcement officer/agency} Volusia Sheriff's Office, swear and affirm that the following facts are true and correct.

1. {Name of Respondent} [REDACTED] poses a significant danger of causing personal injury to himself/herself or others by having a firearm or any ammunition in his/her custody or control or by purchasing, possessing or receiving a firearm or any ammunition. The following specific statements, actions, or facts give rise to a reasonable fear of significant dangerous acts by the respondent:

On December 20, 2023, at approximately 0433 hours, deputies responded to a shoplifting incident at the Wawa located at 3400 Howland Boulevard, Deltona.

The suspect, identified as [REDACTED] stole cigarettes from behind the counter and fled the store in a [REDACTED] Nissan Titan. The store employee reported, during the theft, that [REDACTED] had a knife displayed on his left hip.

AFFIDAVIT CONTINUATION

FROM SECTION 1

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A marked patrol unit attempted a traffic stop on [REDACTED]'s Vehicle at the intersection of Howland Boulevard and Wolfpack Run but he failed to stop.

Additionally, [REDACTED] continued to elude deputies' efforts to arrest him by veering toward responding deputies vehicles and attempting to strike them. Deputies successfully deployed stop sticks to slow down the vehicle. [REDACTED] continued driving his vehicle and parked in his driveway at [REDACTED].

Deputies initiated verbal dialogue with [REDACTED] which ultimately failed, and [REDACTED] fired at deputies, injuring one deputy. Additional units responded, and [REDACTED] lit items on fire in his vehicle. He eventually entered his residence and concealed himself in the attic. After a fire broke out in the house [REDACTED] appeared on the balcony but refused to cooperate. Law enforcement used a Bearcat to strike the balcony and apprehended [REDACTED] in the backyard with the assistance of a K9 unit. He was transported to the hospital for treatment, and the case remains active pending further investigation.
