On April 13th, 2023, at 1935 hours, Deputy Woodin responded to _____, Deltona in reference to possible written threats to kill. Once on the scene Deputy Woodin contacted _____ (W1) and _____ (V1).

_____ stated that on April 13th, at approximately 1432 hours, she received a text message from a number she had not saved. The number was _____. The text starts with "who the fuck do you think you are pussy ass nigga. I know where the fuck you are." The unknown number then asks if she knows _____. When _____ answered with "Who" the unknown number tells _____ "I'm gonna go beat the fuck out of him." _____ then goes back and forth with the number for multiple texts, eventually telling the unknown number she knew it was _____. The unknown number then confirmed his name was _____ by saying "Hi" when _____ stated his name. _____ then proceeds to continue to converse with _____ back and forth. _____ then sends a video of him holding a gun and pointing it at the camera. The conversation ends at approximately 1521 hours with _____ saying to _____ "It's _____ I don't care. I'm gonna shoot _____" _____ then replies, "Sure u are." _____ completed a sworn written statement attesting to this incident. Deputy Woodin collected screenshots of the entire conversation between _____ and _____ and later uploaded them to the digital crime scene database. Deputy Woodin conducted a _____ search of the phone number that was texting _____. The _____ search revealed the phone number provided belongs to _____ (S1). Deputy Woodin collected a screen shot of the _____ information and uploaded it to the digital crime scene database. Deputy Woodin collected a copy of the video sent by _____ to _____ of him and the gun. The video was burned to a CD and submitted as evidence. The CD was placed in a District 4 evidence locker for collection.

Deputy Woodin also contacted _____. _____ was notified of the text messages by _____. _____ stated it made him in fear for his life. _____ has the number texting _____ saved as _____ work phone number, which he showed to Deputy Woodin. _____ stated he has known _____ for several months and was friends with him recently until _____ told _____ to kill himself and handed _____ his gun. It should be noted this incident did not occur recently and was never reported to law enforcement. It should also be noted that _____ was seen driving by _____'s home on April 13th at approximately 1530 hours and stated he wanted to speak to _____ like a real man. It should also be noted that no crime occurred at the time that _____ came to _____'s home. _____ completed a sworn written statement attesting to this incident and stated he wished to pur

pursue criminal charges. [REDACTED] also invoked his right to privacy under the Florida Marsy's Law. [REDACTED] was provided a victims' rights pamphlet.

Deputy Woodin attempted to locate [REDACTED] at his home, however his vehicle was not on scene. Deputy Woodin issued a BOLO for [REDACTED] and his vehicle.

Based on his investigation and the totality of the circumstances, Deputy Woodin determined probable cause exists to charge [REDACTED] with written threats to kill. Due to being unable to locate [REDACTED] a pass on affidavit was completed and placed in the binder at District 4 for oncoming shifts to attempt to locate [REDACTED]

Case Status: Active.

BWC RECORDING

On April 13th, 2023, at 2258 hours, Deputies contacted [REDACTED] in the parking lot of the Walmart, located at 101 Howland Boulevard, Deltona. It should be noted prior to being contacted, Sergeant Carelli spoke to [REDACTED] over the phone at the phone number that texted [REDACTED] which was [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] gave his location to Sergeant Carelli and stated he was willing to speak with law enforcement regarding this incident.

Upon his arrival, Deputy Woodin contacted [REDACTED] who was secured in handcuffs in the back of Deputy Duffy's patrol vehicle. Deputy Woodin read [REDACTED] his Miranda Warnings and rights from his agency issued card. [REDACTED] stated he understood his rights and would speak with Deputy Woodin. [REDACTED] was informed of his charge and that he was under arrest. Deputy Woodin then asked [REDACTED] if his phone was in fact [REDACTED] however he refused to answer the question. Deputy Woodin then asked if [REDACTED] knew [REDACTED], to which he stated he did and that he went to elementary school with him, however has not talked to him for some time. Deputy Woodin then asked [REDACTED] if he had a problem with [REDACTED] to which he stated that [REDACTED] had been calling him a pedophile for unknown reasons. [REDACTED] also stated that [REDACTED] had texted an unknown male that [REDACTED] only knows as [REDACTED] allegedly talking bad about [REDACTED]. When asked how he knew about this, [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] had texted [REDACTED] telling him about the messages. [REDACTED] then gave [REDACTED] a phone number to call that was unknown to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated he called it and spoke to someone

confronting them about the messages [REDACTED] sent but did not elaborate on what the phone number was or what was said in the phone conversation. Deputy Woodin then confronted [REDACTED] about the statement he made to [REDACTED] and the video he sent, but [REDACTED] denied sending both the video and text message about shooting [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] was transported to the Volusia County Branch Jail. His vehicle was towed by Pratt's towing. Deputy Campbell conducted an inventory search of the vehicle and located the gun in the video sent by [REDACTED] to [REDACTED]. The firearm was seized and placed into evidence by Deputy Campbell. Deputy Woodin completed an RPO on [REDACTED] due to threatening harm via a firearm to another person.

Case Status: Arrest/Adult.


