Prior to arrival at the residence, Deputy Campbell contacted by telephone. indicating he was working in Seminole County, but had received suicidal text messages from within the hour. took a screenshot of the text messages and e-mailed them to Deputy Campbell. Deputy Campbell observed the text messages from to contain the following:
"I have to find drugs that I can take that will let me go to sleep and not wake up again I have my guns sitting here but I don't think I could pull the trigger I will have to take drugs in order to end
it and I have a whole container full of painkillers "
The second text message contained the following:
"Nobody understand Jay my brain gives me no rest from this it tortures me all day and all night"
Deputies then responded to the residence in attempt to contact Initially, deputies on scene were unable to locate and observed his white, Ford Flex (FL Tage to be missing from the driveway. As deputies prepared to facilitate a ping of his cellular phone location, arrived on scene. He was then contacted by law enforcement and admitted to sending the text messages and "going through a hard time". appeared uninjured and stated he had not consumed or done anything to hurt himself. Deputy Campbell determined without intervention, there was a substantial likelihood that would hurt himself and or attempt to end his life. He was subsequently placed into protective custody under the Baker Act.

During 's interview with deputies, he refused to provide the whereabouts of his 9MM firearm.
was transported to Stewart Marchman Healthcare in Daytona Beach for evaluation.
