was in a Ford Bronco and armed with a pistol he threatened to use on himself. Upon arrival deputies observed the Bronco in question and tactically parked behind it. From hard cover deputies made verbal announcements via the intercom system. Deputies were unsuccessful with this tactic at which point they made contact with via cell phone.
A dialog was created with in which he told deputies "he lost everything" to include his house, wife and kids. He advised it was over and there is no coming back from what happened. Deputies exchanged several personal experiences and were able to get to kick his gun and knife out of the vehicle and get to the passenger side. Deputies approached the passenger side with a shield for cover and could observe sitting with his hands clear of weapons. While still behind the shield sat with the door open and spoke with Deputy Stubblefield for approximately 10 minutes before we were able to get him to exit without further incident. was cleared of weapons and placed into protective custody.
told deputies he and his wife are separating and she took his kids and house from him and possibly getting back together with her first child's father who is in prison in South Carolina. She told him she is taking his kids and her previous kid to the prison in South Carolina to visit him this weekend which is what triggered the emotions for
While in contact with Deputy Hinkson made contact with the reporting party, (R1), who stated they got into an argument over her not paying his credit card bill and escalated from there. She advised told her not to bury him and that he wanted his kids to spread his ashes because he was going to shoot himself.
Deputies recovered the firearm he threatened to use on himself which was a magazine and gun SN # with a round in the chamber. Along with the gun was a magazine with 8 rounds. All items were collected and submitted into District 2 locker for safe keeping.
A criminal history check of was completed which revealed he does not have any felony convictions.
Through Deputy Stubblefield's investigation it was determined that which out proper care or treatment would likely cause death or serious bodily harm to himself in the near future if not properly treated. was placed into protective custody under the Baker Act.
