On 01/15/2024 at approximately 1950 hours, Deputy Carroll responded to Deltona in reference to a fight. Prior to arriving, Central Dispatched notified responding Deputies (D1), had left the scene on red bicycle possibly armed with a firearm, last seen
Upon arrival, Deputy Carroll made contact with advised she and advised she and had been in a verbal dispute in their bedroom. Stated stated to her that they are done and he was leaving. Stated during the dispute, shad shoved her, knocking her into a dresser. Stated she pushed him off of her and then had struck her with a closed fist on the left side of her head and threatened to kick her in the throat. Deputy Carroll observed redness on the left side of shead by her ear. Stated eft the bedroom and came back with a firearm and set the gun down outside their bedroom before saying goodbye to their children. Stated stated has been taking medication for depression.  Completed a sworn written statement detailing the incident. Was provided with a domestic rights victim's informational rights pamphlet with the assigned case number. declined medical treatment. Stated she did not want to press charges.
Deputy Carroll spoke to (O1), who stated the following:  advised she had heard her parents in a verbal dispute and called law enforcement
heard a noise which she believed to be a gun being loaded.  stated when she exited her room, she observed her father crying and hugging her sister before leaving the residence on a bicycle said her father stated he needs to go to the ER.  completed a sworn written statement detailing the incident.  advised she did not need medical treatment.

RPO submissions group.						
Deputy Carroll seized a Glock 48 (S/N: ), with a Holosun red dot (						
magazine and thirteen 9mm rounds, and a T-Rex IWB holster with attached magazine pouch.						
Deputy Carroll later placed the firearm, magazine, rounds, and holster into the District four						
evidence locker as evidence.						
Deputy Carroll requested a criminal history check on via teletype, which Deputy Carroll						
observed no criminal history.						
At a later time, photos were taken of s injuries and submitted to Axonevidence.org.						
Based on statements and evidence, Deputy Carroll determined was the primary						
aggressor and probable cause existed to charge with domestic violence simple battery.						
was later transported to the Volusia County Branch Jail without incident, Deputy Carroll						
made jail staff aware of suicidal statements while in custody.
