On 06/11/2024 at approximately 2226 hours, Deputy Ortiz observed a black Kia bearing Florida tag traveling east through the 2700 block of Howland Blvd, Deltona. The Seminole County Sheriff's Office had issued a BOLO in reference to the vehicle mentioned above being driven by (V1), whom they had confirmed suicidal statements from via text to his wife, (O1). Deputy Ortiz executed a traffic stop on the vehicle. Deputy Ortiz made contact with who advised he had thoughts of killing himself, but they had subsided as he had been talking to his daughter and his sister on the phone.
Deputy Ortiz determined probable cause existed to place nto protective custody under the Baker Act, both by his own admission to Deputy Ortiz, and from the texts Seminole County deputies had witnessed.
gave deputies permission to take his gun, a 9mm semi-automatic handgun bearing serial number # into safekeeping. The gun was loaded, but not chambered, with 15 brass 9mm bullets. Deputy Ortiz submitted the gun, magazine, and brass rounds to the District 4 Evidence lockers.
During a vehicle inventory, Deputy Taylor located a THC vape pen. admitted he uses the vape pen to calm himself when he is going through mental distress, but also advised he did not have a medical marijuana card. Deputies collected and submitted the vape pen to the District 4 Evidence lockers for disposal.
