

MARSY'S LAW INVOKES

On 06/29/2024 at approximately 2038 hours, Deputy Taylor responded to [REDACTED] Deltona in reference to a domestic violence call that had just occurred. Upon arrival contact was made with [REDACTED] (V1) and her daughter [REDACTED] (O1).

[REDACTED] advised she and her husband [REDACTED] (D1), who are currently married and have a child in common and currently reside in the same residence, are having marital issues. A few months ago, [REDACTED] spoke with [REDACTED] and expressed her wishes to file for divorce. [REDACTED] had told [REDACTED] she had to move out of the residence for an unknown amount of time. [REDACTED] advised after a short amount of time she and [REDACTED] later began to talk and attempted to correct their issues. [REDACTED] moved back into the residence where they both attempted to get along.

[REDACTED] advised Deputy Taylor that today (06/29/2024) she left the residence and went to the gym and while at the gym she received a text from [REDACTED] who stated he was doing his best and trying to be a better man for her. [REDACTED] advised she called [REDACTED] where the two briefly talked before she advised [REDACTED] that their marriage was not working, and she was going to file for divorce. [REDACTED] then heard [REDACTED] began to throw things in the residence and break items.

[REDACTED] advised she immediately left the gym and returned home due to her fear of [REDACTED] home alone with her father. Once she arrived home [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] began to talk before [REDACTED] went into his room. [REDACTED] began to follow him; however, he had retrieved a handgun and stood inside of the doorway to their bedroom. [REDACTED] stopped before entering the room and observed [REDACTED] standing in the door with his handgun in hand. [REDACTED] then raised the firearm and pointed it directly at [REDACTED] and stated he was going to shoot and kill her and then kill himself.

[REDACTED] advised Deputy Taylor, while [REDACTED] was pointing the firearm at her, he was visibly upset, and shaking when he made the threat to kill her. [REDACTED] advised she was in great fear for her life and believed she was going to be shot and killed. [REDACTED] began to back away from [REDACTED] and grabbed [REDACTED] who was seated on the couch in the living room. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] then fled the residence and ran on foot. [REDACTED] could hear [REDACTED] yelling as he too exited the residence and got in his vehicle.

[REDACTED] advised while she was running, she believed [REDACTED] was going to follow after her and kill her. [REDACTED] then took [REDACTED] and hid behind the nearest tree in an attempt to hide from [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] then drove near the tree and yelled to [REDACTED] that he was not going to kill her and that he was going to kill himself and that the cops were going to kill him. He also stated [REDACTED] would have to live the rest of her life knowing she killed him.

[REDACTED] then left the scene in his [REDACTED] bearing Florida tag [REDACTED] in an unknown direction of travel. After speaking with [REDACTED] Deputy Taylor relayed the necessary information over the radio and had units in the area BOLO (be on the lookout) for the aforementioned vehicle.

The vehicle was located by deputies in the area of Interstate 4 and US 17/92 just inside Seminole County. The vehicle began to make its way back into Volusia County where deputies initiated a traffic stop. Contact was made with the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was taken into custody without incident and transported to the district 4 office for paperwork, before he was transported to the Volusia County Branch Jail. Three firearms were located in the vehicle. See Sgt Carelli's supplement regarding the location of the firearms.


Deputy Taylor walked through the residence and noted the residence appeared to have been ransacked. Deputy Taylor provided a victim's rights and remedies packet to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was undecided whether she wished to press charges against [REDACTED].

Due to [REDACTED] being in the residence and overhearing the entire incident Director Quann was made aware along with this report being sent to DCF and Director Quann.
