Deputies were able to locate the grey in color handgun which said she hid in the storage area under the bed once left the house. The firearm was cleared and came back negative as stolen. The Ruger was a grey colored handgun with a magazine containing 6 - nine (9mm)
bullets inside the magazine and one in the chamber at the time it was collected. Deputies were able to get the phone who agreed to return to the residence.
