

On December 11, 2024, deputies responded to [REDACTED] Ormond Beach, in reference to a suicidal person. [REDACTED] contacted VSO Communications and stated her ex-boyfriend and child's father, [REDACTED] threatened to kill himself with a gun to his head. Deputy Laventure talked with [REDACTED] on the phone, who advised she and [REDACTED] were going through a recent break-up. He contacted her today and asked her to get back together with him, which she adamantly denied. [REDACTED] then shared with her he wishes sometimes he didn't wake up. Later in the evening, [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] he had a gun to his head and was going to blow his brains out. [REDACTED] provided Deputy Laventure screenshots of [REDACTED] texting her he wishes he wouldn't wake up, but she also stated he made the suicidal threat with a firearm over the phone. She confirmed [REDACTED] has multiple firearms in the home.

Deputies responded to [REDACTED] Ormond Beach, to attempt to contact [REDACTED] Deputy Laventure established communication with [REDACTED] via phone. His demeanor appeared agitated, but he stated he was not armed. Deputies tactically approached [REDACTED]'s house, where he was located sitting unarmed on the front porch. He was taken into custody under a law enforcement Baker Act and transported to Halifax Hospital. Baker Act paperwork was completed and turned over to Halifax Hospital staff. Deputy Laventure uploaded the text message screenshots to Evidence.com.

On 12/12/2024, at approximately 0830 hours, Deputy Dufour responded to [REDACTED], Ormond Beach, Due to a firearm being located inside the residence.

Deputy Dufour arrived on scene and made contact with [REDACTED] (W1) and [REDACTED] (W2) who advised their daughter [REDACTED] had asked them to come her residence and retrieve some of her belongings. [REDACTED] further advised when he entered the residence, he observed a holstered handgun sitting on the kitchen table, which he found unusual due to [REDACTED] being Baker Acted the night prior. [REDACTED] further advised he removed the magazine from the firearm and cleared the chamber, when [REDACTED] cleared the chamber, he observed three words written on the bullet, one of them being "cure" and the other two words were illegible.

FROM SECTION 1

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Due to the concerning writing on the bullet and the previously documented incident Deputy Dufour completed a risk protection order.

_____ and _____ all completed sworn written statements detailing the incident, advising _____ owns multiple firearms and multiple rounds of ammunition.

The firearm, ammunition, and holster were all submitted to the district 3 North evidence locker as a seizure. Digital photographs of the bullet containing writing were taken and later uploaded into Axon Capture as evidence.
