On Tuesday, February 13, 2024, at approximately 2031 hours, Deputy Westfall (9306) responded to the Publix located at 915 Doyle Rd, Deltona in reference to a disturbance between the occupants of two vehicles. As Deputy Westfall was responding, he was informed by VSO Central Dispatch that caller, (R), advised that he had heard the occupant of a Foyota SUV threaten to shoot the occupants of the other vehicle.
Upon arrival, Deputy Westfall made contact with  (V) who advised he was in the front passenger seat of the  Lexus bearing Florida tag  as his daughter
(V) was in the driver seat of the vehicle. Stated had her learners permit and was learning how to drive.
