Upon arrival, deputies observed a white male and a female in a verbal altercation. The white male was later identified as (V1), as he approached Deputy Galarza he was belligerent and a strong odor of alcoholic beverage was emitting from his mouth. demanded Deputy Galarza place him under the Baker Act since he needs help and was a intoxicated. Due to officer safety. It is shigh level of intoxication, and the above information given by central dispatch of the stepping into on-coming traffic, Deputy Galarza secured in handcuffs and escorted him to the front of Deputy Galarza's patrol vehicle. Once there, violently struck the hood of Deputy Galarza's brand new patrol vehicle with his head several times. Deputies restrained and escorted him to the rear passenger side of the patrol vehicle in which deputies were going to place him in the back of the patrol vehicle. Deputies then observed was going to strike the passenger side of the patrol vehicle with his head due to him moving his head back and then forward. Deputies gently escorted to the ground in order to prevent him from continuing to strike the patrol vehicle with his head. It is did not sustain any injuries as a result of deputies gently taking to the ground. The injuries to were preexisting prior to the arrival of law enforcement.
It shall be noted, Sgt. Medina responded to the scene to document the damage to the front of Deputy Galarza's patrol vehicle. The watch commander, Lt. Calkins, was also on scene.
Deputies made contact with and does not know of any potential narcotics could be on but advised he is a heavy drinker. Said she was attempting to pull out of oncoming traffic and onto the sidewalk for his safety. Advised sueed her knife to cut his wrists in which deputies observed fresh abrasions to several protect her. Deputy Galarza made contact with who said she was "raped" and had reported the incident to law enforcement (see Deland Police case number DL240001876 for further details).

's erratic and harmful behavior, he was subsequently placed into Deputy White's marked							
patrol vehicle. Deputies also placed a hobble, chest restraint and spit hood on

While was receiving medical assistance, he asked Deputy Mechtel (8262) if he could borrow his Volusia Sheriff's Office agency issued weapon to "blow" his brain's out. also stated his girlfriend was raped and he was going to kill "Gary" for doing it. approximately in his forties and a slim build. further stated himself and Gary reside in a							
transient camp at the intersection of Marsh Rd/ E International Speedway., DeLand. When							
Deputy White asked what type of firearm he has, he could only state it is a black Beretta							
9MM pistol. The pistol also is buried eight feet deep underneath his tent.							
no further information in reference to the incident.

Deputy White completed a Risk Protection Order against
