domestic violence incident occurred on 7/10/2025. The domestic violence incident occurred as follows:

Deputy White contacted [REDACTED] (W1) who stated he and his son, [REDACTED] (D1), were in an argument on 7/10/2025 over [REDACTED] touching everyone's belongings in the house. [REDACTED] began arguing with his grandmother, [REDACTED] (V1), when he retrieved his BB gun, held it at chest level and began pushing [REDACTED] with the gun. [REDACTED] intervened and took the gun from [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] provided a sworn written statement documenting his account of the incident. His statements were captured on Deputy Aberle's and Deputy White's Body Worn Camera (BWC).

Deputy White contacted [REDACTED] (W2) who stated the following:

While she was at her desk near the front door, she heard [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] in an argument. During the argument, [REDACTED] said she heard [REDACTED] state to [REDACTED] he was going to kill her. When she turned and observed [REDACTED] he had his BB gun in his hands but did not point the gun at [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] provided a sworn written statement documenting her account of the incident. Her statements were captured on Deputy White's BWC.

Deputy Aberle contacted [REDACTED] who stated the following:

He and his family were in an argument while he had a BB gun in his hands. He stated things happen when he has the gun in his hands but did not elaborate.

[REDACTED] provided a verbal statement documenting his account of the incident. His statements were captured on Deputy Aberle's BWC.

Deputy White contacted [REDACTED] who stated the following:

During the argument on 7/10/2025 she went to the door of her office where [REDACTED] began yelling at her. [REDACTED] had a black colored rifle in his hands, stated he was going to kill her, pointed the gun at her, pulled the trigger 3 times, walked up to her, and put the gun up to her throat.

_____ stepped in saying not to hurt grandma. _____ identified the gun as a rifle with a black barrel, a stock and a scope. She later identified the gun was a BB gun but was in fear _____ was going to harm her at the time.

_____ provided a sworn written statement documenting her account of the incident. Her verbal statement was captured on Deputy White's BWC. _____ elected to keep her information private under Marsy's Law.

Deputy Aberle contacted _____ again and read him his constitutional rights using his agency issued Miranda Warning Card. _____ advised he understood his rights and agreed to speak with deputies. _____ stated the following:

He was in his room with his BB gun when _____ started an argument with him. When _____ was talking to him, _____ spoke up and expressed her displeasures with _____ turned and faced _____ with the gun in his hands when she approached him. _____ admitted to stating he was going to shoot her if she didn't back up. _____ said he pulled the trigger three times, knowing it was only air coming out. _____ approached from behind and pushed him and tried to grab the gun but didn't succeed. _____ went outside, charged it and shot the BB gun with only air coming out of the barrel.

_____ provided a sworn written statement documenting his account of the incident. His statements were captured on Deputy Aberle's BWC.

Deputy White observed _____ neck area which did not have any injuries consistent with a weapon or object being pressed to her neck. Deputy White took photographs of _____ neck area and uploaded them as digital evidence via Axon Capture.

Deputy White was provided with the BB gun, which was submitted to District 2 as evidence. Additionally, Deputy White submitted for a Risk Protection Order on _____

_____ was provided a Victim's Rights and Remedies pamphlet which had the case number listed.

_____, _____, _____ and _____ are all family members related by blood or marriage and were

living together as a family unit classifying this as a domestic violence incident.

Based on the totality of circumstances, and deputies' investigation, Deputy Aberle determined probable cause to arrest [REDACTED] [REDACTED] for Aggravated Assault with a Firearm (DV) and Battery on a Person 65 and Older (DV).

After notifying [REDACTED] parents of his arrest, they began altering their statements. While reading [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] statements, deputies noticed they were either missing information that was provided on a verbal statement or different from what they said. [REDACTED] written statement did not mention anything about [REDACTED] pushing [REDACTED] with the gun. When questioned about it, [REDACTED] stated, "Thats my statement, isn't it?"

All paperwork was submitted to District 2 records.

[REDACTED] was transported to VCBJ without further incident.

For the foregoing reasons, petitioner requests the Court to enter:

1. Immediately surrender all firearms and ammunition in his or her custody, control, or possession and any license to carry a concealed weapon or firearm to the *{name of law enforcement agency}*; VOLUSIA SHERIFFS OFFICE
2. Not have in his/her custody, control, or possession any firearm or ammunition while this order is in effect;
3. Not purchase, possess, receive, or attempt to purchase or receive, a firearm or ammunition while this order is in effect; and
4. Abide by any other lawful relief the Court may order.

Petitioner further requests this Court to schedule a Hearing for a Risk Protection Order to be held within 14 days.

____ A **RISK PROTECTION ORDER** in this matter requiring Respondent to:

1. Immediately surrender all firearms and ammunition in his or her custody, control, or possession and any license to carry a concealed weapon or firearm to the *{name of law enforcement agency}*; _____
2. Not have in his/her custody, control, or possession any firearm or ammunition while this order is in effect;
3. Not purchase, possess, receive, or attempt to purchase or receive, a firearm or ammunition while this order is in effect; and
4. Abide by any other lawful relief the Court may order.

Petitioner requests the Risk Protection Order to remain in effect for a period the Court deems appropriate, up to and including but not exceeding 12 months.
