1. {Name of Respondent} _____ poses a significant danger of causing personal injury to himself/herself or others by having a firearm or any ammunition in his/her custody or control or by purchasing, possessing or receiving a firearm or any ammunition. The following specific statements, actions, or facts give rise to a reasonable fear of significant dangerous acts by the respondent:

On 10/02/2025, at approximately 1524 hours, Deputy Wickham responded to _____, Deland, to follow up on a previous case involving _____, a resident there, being Baker Acted by Volusia Sheriff Deputies. The associated incident occurred on 09/17/2025 with a case number of VP250019160.

AFFIDAVIT CONTINUATION

FROM SECTION 2
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Deputy Wickham was made aware that earlier in the day, [REDACTED] had been baker acted in Seminole County while attending a family therapy session with his parents. The therapy session was located at Caya Health and the family therapist determined that [REDACTED] was acting so out of character and so erratic that a 911 call was made. [REDACTED] was subsequently baker acted by Seminole County Deputies and transported to the local baker act facility, located in Longwood, Florida. [REDACTED] was determined to be held at the facility until the earliest date of 10/05/2025.

[REDACTED]'s mother, [REDACTED], told Deputy Wickham that [REDACTED] had recently come into possession of a handgun and believes an emergency Risk Protection Order should be put in place due to [REDACTED]'s behavior and her belief that he is a risk to himself and others. [REDACTED] advised she and her husband, [REDACTED] confronted [REDACTED] regarding the firearm on Tuesday, September 30th, and a verbal dispute began which resulted in [REDACTED] telling [REDACTED] "If you call the cops on me again or I am baker acted again, there will be no more you or I". Both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] believe [REDACTED] is an extreme risk to himself and society while being in possession of a firearm. When [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] asked where he bought the firearm, [REDACTED] stated it is not his and he was holding it for a friend. Both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] believed [REDACTED]'s statements to be a lie and found the box associated to the firearm in [REDACTED]'s truck. The firearm is a Springfield Armory handgun (S/N [REDACTED] and when checked in the FCIC/NCIC database to be stolen, yielded negative results. Both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] provided sworn written statements.

Deputy Wickham conducted a criminal history check on [REDACTED] that resulted in no history. Deputy Wickham recently took protective custody of [REDACTED] under the Baker Act on 09/17/2025 and observed his behavior towards deputies as well as his parents to be hostile and aggressive. Due to his recent experiences with [REDACTED] coupled with the information he was being given, Deputy Wickham determined [REDACTED] to be of potential risk to himself or others while being in possession of a firearm. Deputy Wickham completed an emergency risk protection order.

3. Affiant is is not aware of any existing protection order governing the respondent under any applicable statute.




