On 11/16/2025, at approximately 18:30 hours, deputies responded to Circle K, located at 1859 Providence Boulevard, Deltona regarding an aggravated assault with a subsequent traffic crash (See VP250023455 for additional.)

Upon arrival, Deputy Campbell contacted _____ (V1) who provided the following statement:

_____ drove to the Circle K to complete a narcotic transaction of a THC vape cartridge. _____ pregnant girlfriend, RS, a minor, (O1) accompanied him in the front passenger seat. _____ sold the cartridge to a female he only knows through other friends as "_____", a minor. After the transaction was completed, he received a text message from an unknown number from a subject wishing to purchase a THC cartridge. Although he was unfamiliar with the unknown number, he and RS returned to the Circle K to conduct a second narcotic transaction with the requestor. _____ parked near the air pump of the Circle K and waited for the unknown person to arrive. As he waited, he noticed a silver pickup truck arrive and park suspiciously behind him. _____ exited his vehicle and approached the silver pickup truck. RS remained inside of their vehicle. Upon approaching the driver's door, the driver, later identified as _____ (D1) acknowledged he was there to purchase a THC cartridge. _____ then began questioning _____ if he knew his daughter, _____. _____ stated he did, at which point, he noticed _____ was holding a silver and black, semi auto handgun, possibly Glock 9MM, in his hand, upon his lap. _____ stated _____ then demanded to follow _____ home to speak with his parents and threatened to kill him. _____ immediately retreated back to his vehicle as he was in fear for his life. _____ then frantically entered his vehicle and fled the parking lot, onto Elkcarn Boulevard. _____ followed _____ vehicle through the Circle K parking lot and out onto Elkcarn Boulevard. _____ noticed he was being followed by _____ and became even more anxious. _____ subsequently failed to notice he had a red light at the intersection of Providence Boulevard and Elkcarn and collided with an uninvolved motorist. After the collision, both _____ and his girlfriend fled their disabled vehicle and ran to the rear of 1851 Elkcarn Boulevard as _____ was still in fear for his life. At that point, he contacted 911 for assistance. While waiting for law enforcement's arrival, _____ went to see if emergency personnel had arrived. He then observed _____ truck was parked at the Circle K, on east side of the building. He then noticed that _____ was standing near a road sign on Providence Boulevard, in front the same. _____ stated _____ called out to him to come over to him and taunted him about the crash. He stated _____ hands were positioned at his sides as he taunted him and he believed _____ was still armed. He then yelled out to _____ that he called the police and then concealed himself again behind 1851 Elkcarn Boulevard. _____ provided Deputy Campbell a sworn statement regarding these facts and indicated he wished to pursue criminal charges. He was explained Marsy's Law and invoked his right to have his information protected from public view.

_____ described _____ as a white male, approximately forty years old, with short brown hair, a full beard, and wearing an unknown color hoodie. He added that he observed an unknown tattoo upon _____ left hand as well. He described the truck _____ had been driving as silver or gray and newer model.

_____ provided Deputy Campbell telephone number _____" as the phone number he communicated with _____ on to coordinate the sale of the THC cartridge. He added that he also conversed with _____ via Instagram as well. Deputy Campbell utilized law enforcement databases which indicated the phone number was associated with _____ (O2) of _____, Deltona. Deputies responded to the area of _____ and observed a silver, Chevrolet Colorado (FL Tag _____) parked in the driveway. While awaiting other deputies to arrive to the residence, Deputy Ortiz observed a white male, with a beard frantically moving about the garage. After a few minutes, the male closed the garage and exited the residence through the front door with a female. The male and female then entered into the silver Chevrolet Colorado and drove away from the residence, towards S Acadian Drive. At that time, deputies observed a rear running light of the Colorado to be defective and conducted a traffic stop on the Chevrolet Colorado in front of 1690 Agate Circle. At that time, _____ and _____ were positively identified and _____ was subsequently detained in handcuffs.

Deputy Campbell then transported _____ to 1690 Agate Circle to conduct a show up. As Deputy Campbell passed by other deputies who were standing with _____ confirmed _____ was the male that threatened to kill him while holding a silver and black handgun. When asked how sure _____ was, he stated he was one hundred percent sure. He additionally confirmed the silver Chevrolet Colorado nearby was the same truck _____ was driving during the incident. A Volusia Sheriff's Office Show Up Form was completed detailing these facts. The show up form was submitted to Volusia Sheriff's Office Records via interoffice mail.

Deputies contacted the on-duty employee of Circle K who provided deputies access to their surveillance cameras. Within the surveillance footage, deputies observed [REDACTED] vehicle, a gray GMC SUV (FL Tag [REDACTED]) is parked near the air pump in the parking lot. A silver Chevrolet Colorado parks behind [REDACTED] vehicle. [REDACTED] vehicle travels slightly forward, and the silver Chevrolet Colorado follows. Both vehicles loop around an island containing two gas pumps. Both vehicles then stop in the aisle area between an additional set of gas pumps. The driver's window is down, and observed driving the Colorado is a white male, with a full brown beard, with his left hand and arm visible upon the window frame. A tattoo upon driver's left hand is visible. [REDACTED] exits his vehicle and approaches the Chevrolet Colorado. [REDACTED] abruptly backs up from the Chevrolet Colorado and retreats towards his vehicle. [REDACTED] then re-enters his vehicle. Both vehicles then abruptly leave the Circle K parking lot. Due to the distance of the camera, the interior of the Chevrolet Colorado is not visible nor is the driver's right hand. However, it is apparent that the Chevrolet Silverado aggressively follows [REDACTED] vehicle out of the parking lot and onto Elkcam Boulevard. This is evident by the obvious rapid acceleration of the Chevrolet Colorado immediately following [REDACTED] vehicle as it flees the parking lot, to include dismissing the posted stop sign prior to entering the roadway of Elkcam Boulevard. A copy of the surveillance footage was uploaded to Evidence.com.

Deputies read [REDACTED] his Miranda Warning from a department issued card. [REDACTED] indicated he wished to have a lawyer present before speaking with law enforcement.

Deputy Campbell then spoke with [REDACTED] stated the following: [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] had arrived home from visiting family out of town around 16:00 hours. At approximately 17:00 hours, she began to act "weird and funny". She then requested money to purchase ice from the Circle K. After a few minutes, [REDACTED] left walking to Circle K. Upon her arrival, [REDACTED] was still acting "weird and funny" and was confronted by her parents. At that time, they learned she had lied to them and had purchased a THC cartridge. [REDACTED] then took [REDACTED]'s cellphone to review the contents. He then observed her conversation with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] then texted [REDACTED] from his own cell phone, soliciting him to purchase a THC cartridge. The two agreed to meet at the same Circle K [REDACTED] had met [REDACTED] at earlier. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that he confronted [REDACTED] about selling a

THC vape to a minor and asked to follow him home to speak with his parents. [REDACTED] then left out of the parking lot and got into a crash. After observing the crash, [REDACTED] drove home to [REDACTED]. Once he arrived home, he told [REDACTED] about confronting [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] getting into a car crash immediately afterwards. [REDACTED] then had a panic attack and had to be consoled by [REDACTED] with a cold, damp cloth. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] discussed that [REDACTED] was not involved in the crash aspect, so there was no need for him to contact law enforcement. A few minutes later, [REDACTED] received a message from [REDACTED] indicating "her father was going to jail for a long time." After learning of that message, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] got into the Chevrolet Colorado to respond to the Circle K to speak with deputies on scene. However, they were pulled over a short distance from their home instead. [REDACTED] indicated the family does have firearms to include a handgun but could not provide a description of any of them. She indicated they're kept inside of a gun safe and that neither she or [REDACTED] carries a concealed firearms on a daily basis or keep firearms in their vehicles. She added that [REDACTED] was inside of the residence and awaiting her and [REDACTED] to return home.

A criminal history check of [REDACTED] yielded no felony convictions.

[REDACTED] was issued a UTC for the inoperable running lights of the Chevrolet Colorado by Deputy Ortiz (AMH6KAE).

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] refused to provide deputies with consent to search both their residence as well as the Chevrolet Colorado. On call detectives were notified who drafted search warrants for each in attempt to obtain the firearm described by [REDACTED] as the one [REDACTED] used to threaten his life (See Detective Richardson's supplement for additional information.) While securing the residence for the search warrant, [REDACTED] exited the home.

Deputy Ortiz spoke with [REDACTED] with [REDACTED] present. She provided the following statement: She coordinated a THC cartridge purchase with [REDACTED]. She lied to her parents about going to the Circle K to purchase ice so she could meet with [REDACTED]. Upon [REDACTED] return home, her parents confronted her about her behavior and asked her to produce her change. At that time, she handed over the THC cartridge to them and explained she had met [REDACTED] at the Circle K to purchase it. Her parents then took possession of her phone.

After thorough interviews with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] coupled with the observation of the surveillance footage of Circle K and the traffic crash supportive of [REDACTED] sworn statement, Deputy Campbell determined probable cause existed to charge [REDACTED] with aggravated assault with a deadly weapon.

Search incident to arrest yielded a Samsung cellular phone in [REDACTED] front pants pocket. Deputy Campbell called the phone number provided by [REDACTED] as one he used to communicate the details of the THC cartridge transaction ([REDACTED]). At that time, the Samsung cellular phone located in [REDACTED] possession rang.

It should be noted during the execution of the residential search warrant of [REDACTED], three handguns from within were obtained by Detective Richardson. These handguns were packaged and submitted to a District Four evidence locker. See Detective Richardson's supplement for additional details.

Director Quann was notified of the incident in real time.

A copy of this report was uploaded to DCF's website for their review.

[REDACTED] was transported to the Volusia County Branch Jail.
