Upon arrival, Deputy Conroy made contact with V1) who advised her husband D1) pushed out of the doorway when she tried to enter their home and discharged a firearm into the walkway during the struggle. It should be noted, that and have children in common and have been married and living together for over 10 years.
advised that she and had been going through problems with infidelity and were in the process of getting a divorce. Apopka to meet his girlfriend. Completed all relevant domestic violence paperwork and was provided with a victim's rights pamphlet with a corresponding case number. had been going through problems with infidelity and were in the process of getting a divorce. Advised she had come home from being out with friends and was met at the front door by stated she and got into a verbal argument that turned physical when he pushed her to prevent her from coming into the home that they both share. Stated she initially did not know that was holding a gun but became aware when discharged the firearm into the walkway where she was standing. Stated she was in fear when she saw the firearms and heard it discharge. Described the firearm as a greenish semiautomatic pistol. Stated unloaded the firearm and drove away from residence with the firearm still in his possession. Suspected he may be heading to Apopka to meet his girlfriend. Completed all relevant domestic violence paperwork and was provided with a victim's rights pamphlet with a corresponding case number. Completed a sworn written statement which corroborated her verbal statement. Later advised she did not wish to pursue charges on
Deputy Conroy took photos of and observed no obvious injuries.
Deputy Conroy observed a small crater outside the front door with lead spalling in the center. Deputies later discovered a spent 9mm casing with a Winchester headstamp. The casing was collected in a clear plastic evidence bag and photos were taken of the bullet indent in the walkway.

While on scene called a family member, asking to speak to the Deputies. Deputy Conroy spoke with and arranged for him to meet the Deputies at the Circle K gas station located at 130 Grand Av, DeLand. Deputies secured in handcuffs. Deputy Conroy read his rights from his agency-issued Miranda warning card, which stated he understood. stated he was worried that the person who dropped off at the house would try and barge in because is "spiteful". stated he did not see anyone else standing with her in the doorway but knew someone was in the car that dropped her off. stated he and pushed back and forth in the doorway when the gun suddenly went off. stated that he was shocked by what had happened and unloaded the firearm. stated he left the residence because he needed to get separated and calm down. was unable provide a reasonable justification for being in possession of the firearm while arguing with his wife at the front door.
gave consent to enter his vehicle and secure the 9mm flat dark earth FN 509 tactical (GKS0348078). Deputy Conroy found the handgun on the passenger side floorboard with the slide closed and the magazine ejected from the gun. Deputy Conroy observed there were 16 rounds in the magazine which had the same Winchester head stamping.
Based on Deputy Conroy's investigation, he determined probable cause existed to charge with DV aggravated assault with a deadly weapon and DV battery.
Deputy Conroy conducted a criminal history check on which revealed no prior charges or convictions.
All photos of evidentiary value were later uploaded to Axon Capture for evidence. All items of evidentiary value were later submitted to a District 2 evidence locker as evidence. Due to the involvement of a firearm, an RPO was later completed. Due to children being present in the home, Director Quan was made aware, and a copy of this report was sent to DCF.

For the foregoing reasons, petitioner requests the Court to enter:

 - 2. Not have in his/her custody, control, or possession any firearm or ammunition while this order is in effect;
 - 3. Not purchase, possess, receive, or attempt to purchase or receive, a firearm or ammunition while this order is in effect; and
 - 4. Abide by any other lawful relief the Court may order.

Petitioner further requests this Court to schedule a Hearing for a Risk Protection Order to be held within 14 days.

X A RISK PROTECTION ORDER in this matter requiring Respondent to:

- 1. Immediately surrender all firearms and ammunition in his or her custody, control, or possession and any license to carry a concealed weapon or firearm to the *{name of law enforcement agency}*; VOLUSIA SHERIFF'S OFFICE
- 2. Not have in his/her custody, control, or possession any firearm or ammunition while this order is in effect;
