

"as wearing a long sleeve highlighter yellow/green shirt and jeans. confirmed "as wearing a long sleeve highlighter yellow/green shirt and jeans. who was identified as
did not recognize the second male and described him to be around forty years of age, short, buzzed hair that is balding, blue shirt, blue shorts, and appeared Hawaiian or Hispanic. stated this male had a handgun. explained the third male was in a bulldozer which he could not see inside of.
explained the Hispanic males intended on destroying his homeless camp. stated as the bulldozer approached, a verbal altercation ensued between and "Louring this verbal altercation, stated he was shirtless and never had any items in his hands. advised "Louring to the would have to shoot him." later fired two shots at the feet of the which did not strike

him. explained he was in fear for his life and believed "had the capability to take his life in that moment.
After the gunshots, striend called law enforcement and advised to the Hispanic male's law enforcement is coming. Stated the males decided to retreat to the residence on the property. It noted, him and hid in their handmade structure until law enforcement ordered them out and secured them. Informed Detective Forster he wished to pursue criminal charges due to him being in fear for his life. Swore to her verbal testimony which was also audio recorded.
Detective Forster later made contact with who corroborated statement. advised during the verbal altercation she was holding their two dogs while the second Hispanic male with a handgun pointed the gun at her and the dogs. explained the male stated, "I will shoot those dogs". stated she was in fear for her life as well and wished to pursue criminal charges. swore to her verbal testimony which was audio recorded.
Patrol deputies informed Detective Forster that was advised of his constitutional rights via an agency issued Miranda card, which he understood and did not wish to speak with Detective Forster.
Through Detective Forster's investigation, coupled with physical evidence and statements, Detective Forster determined probable cause exists to charge with two counts of aggravated assault.
was later transported to VCBJ without incident.
A search warrant was conducted of residence and nine firearms were located in the residence and inside vehicle. Also recovered was 75.2 grams of suspected cocaine. was additionally charged with armed trafficking of cocaine.

- 1. Immediately surrender all firearms and ammunition in his or her custody, control, or possession and any license to carry a concealed weapon or firearm to the *{name of law enforcement agency}*;
- 2. Not have in his/her custody, control, or possession any firearm or ammunition while this order is in effect;
- 3. Not purchase, possess, receive, or attempt to purchase or receive, a firearm or ammunition while this order is in effect; and
- 4. Abide by any other lawful relief the Court may order.

Petitioner further requests this Court to schedule a Hearing for a Risk Protection Order to be held within 14 days.

X A RISK PROTECTION ORDER in this matter requiring Respondent to:

- 1. Immediately surrender all firearms and ammunition in his or her custody, control, or possession and any license to carry a concealed weapon or firearm to the *{name of law enforcement agency}*; Volusia Sheriff's Office
- 2. Not have in his/her custody, control, or possession any firearm or ammunition while this order is in effect;
- 3. Not purchase, possess, receive, or attempt to purchase or receive, a firearm or ammunition while this order is in effect; and
- 4. Abide by any other lawful relief the Court may order.

Petitioner requests the Risk Protection Order to remain in effect for a period the Court deems appropriate, up to and including but not exceeding 12 months.
