On November 26, 2025, Deputy Nelson was dispatched to the listed address for a report of a suicidal subject.

Prior to arrival on scene central dispatch advised a 911 call came from a doctor's office in Orlando. The reporting person stated they were talking to a patient later identified as ██████████. While speaking with ██████████ she was becoming increasingly angry over issues with her prescriptions and receiving health care. At some point in the conversation, ██████████ stated something to the effect of she would get a gun and shoot herself.

On scene Deputy Nelson made contact with ██████████ at her residence. ██████████ was in a very angry state and appeared very irritable. ██████████ came outside and agreed to talk with Deputy Nelson about the issues. ██████████ had no weapon in her hands and proceeded to attempt to calm down and speak with Deputy Nelson.

██████████ stated she was on the phone for most of the morning trying to get her medications filled with her primary care doctor. The doctor's office stated they already filled the medications and could not fill more prescriptions without a doctor's approval. After a long time on the phone ██████████ advised the issue was the prescriptions were sent to the wrong pharmacy. ██████████ requested these be fixed and at no cost to her which there was a further issue with. According to ██████████ she was incredibly frustrated with her doctors and the outcome of this issue. ██████████ stated to the doctors, "I might as well go and get my gun out of the safe and blow my brains out." ██████████ then hung up the phone and continued about her day until Deputies arrived.

██████████ ultimately agreed to surrender her firearm pending a risk protection order being complete by Deputy Carrol. Deputies took possession of the firearm which was threatened to be used in this incident as well as several rounds of ammunition. An RPO/TRPO was completed in this incident and submitted for review.

Based on the totality of the circumstances it was determined more likely than not without proper mental health care and evaluation; ██████████ poses a substantial risk of harming herself. ██████████ was placed into protective custody under the Baker Act and transported to Halifax Hospital.
