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vehicle (bearing FL tag [REDACTED]) in the DeLand Area. A phone ping of his cellphone revealed [REDACTED] to be in the area of Amelia Av., DeLand. Volusia Sheriff's Office Deputies and DeLand Police Department Officers immediately began to canvass the surrounding area for [REDACTED] and the vehicle. Law enforcement subsequently located [REDACTED] driving the Telsa and conducted a traffic stop at the intersection of W Minnesota Av/ Big Pine Key Blvd., DeLand, to which [REDACTED] was taken into custody without incident.

Deputy White made contact with [REDACTED] to which he advised he never made any suicidal statements and claimed he was going back home since he spoke to Lake County Sheriff's Office on telephone. [REDACTED] provided no further information in reference to the incident.

Deputy White made contact with Lake County Sheriff's Office Deputy Parish #2530 via telephone. Deputy Parish informed Deputy White that Lake County Sheriff's Office was informed to go out to [REDACTED]'s residence at [REDACTED] DeLand, FL (Lake County) to make contact with him. Upon arrival, Lake County Deputies made contact with [REDACTED]'s Wife, [REDACTED] (O1) who advised he got into argument with her and went on a live stream Tik Tok video stating he was going to kill himself. Also, before leaving the residence, [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] he was going to kill himself and he was armed with a handgun. Deputy Parish collected a sworn affidavit from [REDACTED] which was later forwarded to Deputy White. The screen shots of the affidavit was subsequently uploaded to Axon as evidence. Deputy Parish also informed Deputy White she did not observe the live stream due to it being deleted. Deputy Parish provided no further information in reference to the incident.

Based on the information Deputy White determined without proper care or treatment, [REDACTED] could be a harm to himself and others. Deputy White placed [REDACTED] into protective custody under the Baker Act Statute. Also, due to the fact [REDACTED] made suicidal statements and was armed with a firearm during the incident, Deputy White completed a risk protection order against [REDACTED]. Deputy White collected the following firearms from [REDACTED]:

- 1) Black Target Model Ruger 22/45 MK III .22 Caliber Long Rifle Pistol (serial number #271-14933)
- 2) Black Gamo Air Rifle with scope (NO SERIAL NUMBER)
- 3) Black Remington Airmaster 77 .177 Caliber/ Pellet BB Repeater
- 4) One .22 Caliber silver magazine

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Deputy White subsequently submitted the items into the District Two locker for safe keeping (RPO). _____ also arrived on scene and took possession of the Telsa vehicle.

_____ was later removed from FCIC/NCIC as missing/ endangered by Lake County Sheriff's Office Teletype unit. Deputy White later transported _____ to the Stewart Marchman Facility, located in Daytona Beach for further assistance.
